regulations for fast and abstinence:

Fasting is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed.

Abstinence is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the parish priest should be consulted.

Ash Wednesday (18 Feb.), Good Friday, (3 April), and all Fridays of lent are days of fast and abstinence. Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. The faithful and catechumens should undertake these practices seriously in a spirit of penance and of preparation for baptism or renewal of baptismal vows at Easter.

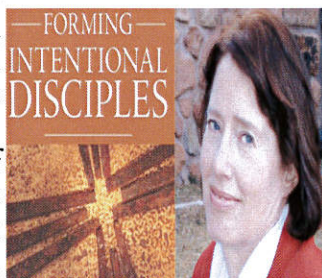

bishop's annual appeal:

what is it? The BAA is a primary source of funding to help sustain and expand ministries in the 95 parishes, 21 missions, 33 Catholic Schools, and agencies throughout the diocese. Each parish and mission is asked to participate in this worthy appeal.

How are parish BAA targets determined?

It is an objective formula based on a parish's annual assessable income. Each parish is assigned a percentage, or fair share, of the overall \$3,000,000 goal as their BAA parish target. This percentage is the same percentage that their parish assessment represents compared to the overall diocesan assessment. For example, is a parish's annual diocesan assessment represents 1% of the overall diocesan assessment amount, then their BAA target will represent 1% of the \$3,000,000 overall goal.
