I am noticing more and more people in the area interested in spiritual direction. They often come across the concept while reading lives of the saints or spiritual works. People who are seeking to grow in holiness in an intentional way are often attracted to the idea of spiritual direction, but not sure what it is.

There are two main types of spiritual direction. One is when someone approaches a priest or competent layperson to discuss a particular situation, person in their life, or event that they need advice on. The other is when faithful Catholics want to enter into a relationship with a priest or layperson who is trained in directing a person in a general and specific ways to greater holiness. The director is not a guru or a spiritual expert, and while it is best to have a director who is both holy and intelligent, as St Teresa of Avila pointed out, even holy people can get things terrible wrong, so it is more important to have someone who knows what they are doing.

A good director takes time to get to know the person and what they really want. Sometime the director will realize that the person just needs more regularity in practices of piety and good works, and more frequent prayer and reception of the sacraments, to grow in holiness. With priests few and far between, and with their demands, some priests even think of direction as akin to "elective surgery" that the vast majority do not need. But, direction can be helpful for anyone.

Sometimes a director works within the framework of a certain school of spirituality within the Church, guiding a directee to the principal spiritual insights of one of these schools. Third Orders, like the Dominicans, Carmelites and Franciscans, who are all active in Greenville, provide this spiritual formation for many people. Sometimes the newer ecclesial movements, like Opus Dei, Regnum Christi or Communion and Liberation, provide this function. They provide a framework and structures of accountability within which many people thrive.

You may not know that in the parish, our own Lisa Buss has received training and formation in spiritual direction. If you are interested in learning more, it might be a good idea to drop her a line at spiritualdirection@princeofpeacetaylors.org to schedule a meeting to assess how spiritual direction might be fruitful to you.

Currently I have a few regular directees, and a few more sporadic ones. Because the number of these has grown, and I believe in the value of such direction, my available appointments are going more and more to those who are looking for such direction. I am holding off on accepting directees from other parishes, because there is only so much time in any one day, and my principal duty is to Prince of Peace. There are other options in the area, and I would encourage you to reach out to Lisa to learn more.
