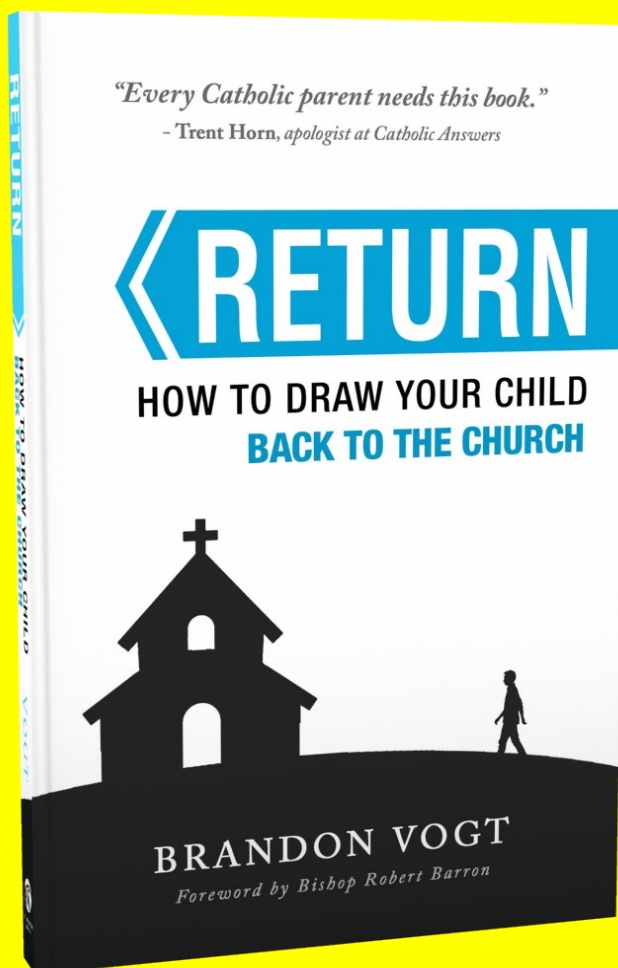

### problems receiving your envelopes?

We have heard you! We are changing to a new envelope provider beginning with your Sept/Oct envelope packet, which should arrive sometime in August. The weekly offertory envelope will look the same. All of the envelopes will have a bar code on the back to help us more efficiently and accurately record your contributions.
