**resumed fifth sunday after epiphany (EF)**

Several years ago, Prince of Peace was the beneficiary of several large donations. We have used those donations for a number of purposes. They have helped fund projects of Phase I of the Master Plan. They have also allowed us to pay off the debt on the church, purchase the 8 acres of land next to the parish which had come due, provide space for our St Vincent de Paul Chapter, help pay for the modular building, demolish the old rectory and to contribute to part of the building of the first phase of the new school. We have been able to accomplish an incredible number of things with the money provided by incredibly generous souls who made large donations or left Prince of Peace substantial amounts of money in their wills, because they believed in our parish and what we could accomplish.

While all of those projects were going on, however, some significant maintenance projects – mainly involving roofs and HVAC – came barreling down on us that we absolutely had to address. Because of these necessary expenses, the generous funds which we had a few years ago are now quite depleted.

To finish the school building and pay for it, we have asked the diocese for a small bridge loan so that we do not allow our reserves to drop below \$200,000. Funds from the POP Art party will help us to pay that off as quickly as we can. This means that, of the projects included in Part I of our Master Plan, we will not begin construction of a new parish administration building this fiscal year.

We would like for you to consider how Prince of Peace figures in your last will and testament, and how significant donations can make an incredible impact on our future. We have been able to do a lot of capital projects without asking for contributions from the parish. However, the depletion of these donations means that we are now left with merely our reserve and the donations that come from the offertory each week.

When we were paying off the debt on the church, many people switched their giving from weekly offertory to debt reduction, instead of giving twice. Because of that, much maintenance was deferred which came home to roost in the last two years, and programming, ministries and staff were reduced to the bare minimum. Now is the time to reassess our stewardship. In the bulletin each week, we post as our goal \$25,000 a week. That is a goal that would allow us to do much of what we think a parish of this size needs to do to function well. We are far below that goal most of that time. That requires careful attention to expenses, but what it also means is that if we continue to go below our goal much of what some people have come to think of as the services common to our parish will have to be eliminated or drastically reduced.

I would like to ask all of you who call Prince of Peace your spiritual home to ask how you are giving your ten percent, your tithe, and how your parish fits into it. If you have specific questions about what our operations look like and why money is spent as it is, please do not make assumptions or listen to scurrilous gossip. Ask. Chris Bourne is in the office during the week and will be glad to answer questions and help you see the great value your continued support brings our parish.

God loves a cheerful giver, and when we give sacrificially and happily, confident that our investment in our parish is sound, amazing things can happen! Thank you for all you do.

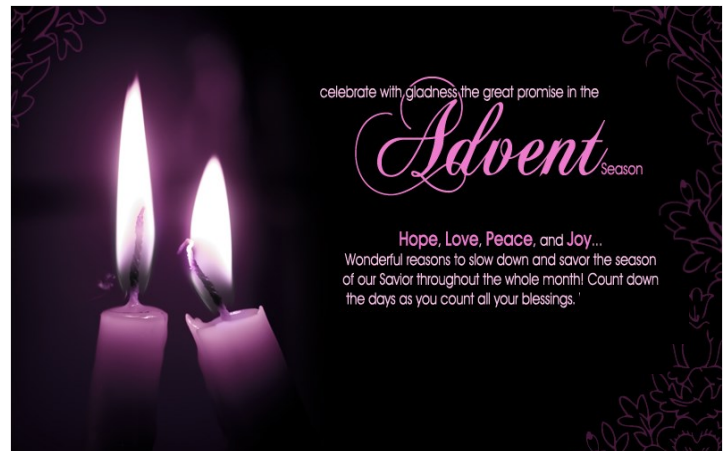

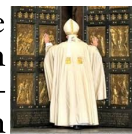
