# From the Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

Tomorrow, I leave for ten days in Portugal. A few months ago, I received a phone call out of nowhere that a benefactor wanted to pay for a priest friend and me to go to Fatima during the 100th anniversary year. I never would have thought that in one year I would be able to go to two major Marian shrines, this after my trip to Walsingham in England in June. If you have any special prayer requests you want me to bring over to the shrine, please email them to me by midnight tonight (19 November), so I can gather them and present them at the shrine. I know that for some of you it is difficult to go on pilgrimage, so please know that I am intentionally making this pilgrimage for those who can't go themselves. In 1982, St John Paul II consecrated the world to Mary. In that act, he prayed:

*Oh, Immaculate Heart! Help us to conquer the menace of evil, which so easily takes root in the hearts of the people of today, and whose immeasurable effects already weigh down upon our modern world and seem to block the paths towards the future!*

*From famine and war, deliver us.*

*From nuclear war, from incalculable self-destruction, from every kind of war, deliver us.*

*From sins against the life of man from its very beginning, deliver us.*

*From hatred and from the demeaning of the dignity of the children of God, deliver us.*

*From every kind of injustice in the life of society, both national and international, deliver us.*

*From readiness to trample on the commandments of God, deliver us.:*

*From attempts to stifle in human hearts the very truth of God, deliver us.*

*Accept, O Mother of Christ, this cry laden with the sufferings of all individual human beings, laden with the sufferings of whole societies.*

*Let there be revealed, once more. in the history of the world your infinite power of merciful Love. May it put a stop to evil. May it transform consciences. May your Immaculate Heart reveal for all the light of Hope.*

## fr smith’s advent reading recommendation

- **Men:** I would like for you to read *That Nothing May Be Lost: Reflections on Catholic Doctrine and Devotion* by Father Paul Scalia. Fr Scalia is a priest of the Arlington diocese and son of recently deceased Supreme Court Judge Antonin Scalia. This wide ranging book talks about the role of grace, the sacraments, Mary and so much more in the life of Christian discipleship.
- **Women:** I invite you to read *Daring to Hope: Finding God’s Goodness in the Broken and the Beautiful* by Katie Majors. Katie is a young American Protestant missionary who founded Amazima Ministries to spread the Gospel in Uganda. As a single woman, she adopted 14 orphans! She recounts her incredible story of God’s faithfulness in a unique vocation of love and how she found a Christian helpmate in holy marriage.
- **Married and Engaged Couples:** I want to challenge you. I would like for you to read your book during Advent, and then in the new year, swap books with your partner. And I want you, as a New Years Resolution, already to schedule two date nights to go out and have a drink or a coffee and talk about what you’ve read. I know it sounds silly, but I think when our couples can get together with a spiritual project and share their insights reading, it can be very powerful.

You know how I am fond of classical Catholic spiritual literature. These two books are recent publications, and one written by a Protestant. But both works have a lot to nourish the soul. Advent is a time of new beginnings, and these two spiritual books have the possibility of really raising a lot of good discussions!



## EVENING PRAYER ACCORDING TO THE TRADITIONAL ROMAN BREVIARY IN ENGLISH

From the earliest centuries of the Church, Christians gathered in the evening on the Lord's Day to sing psalms, hymns and spiritual canticles. The official public evening prayer of the Church's Liturgy of the Hours is Vespers, named after the Vesper Star that rises to herald the fall of night. At Vespers, we sing five psalms; we listen to the Word of God, sing a hymn for the Evening. The highlight of the service is the Magnificat, the Canticle of Mary, in which the Altar and the Faithful are incensed as sign of honor and our prayers rising to God. After a prayer, we visit the Lady Altar to ask Mary's protection during the night.
