

Dear Friends in Christ,

You hear a lot nowadays about how religion has become the preserve of women, and that men are abandoning the practice of the Catholic faith in worrying amounts. I have to say, that is certainly not my experience here at Prince of Peace. I can't tell you how edifying it is to see so many men of all ages who come to Mass, Adoration, and participate in the life of the parish at all levels. One of the most fascinating phenomena in the Catholic Church is how, in places that have a rich traditional liturgical and devotional life, men are attracted to Catholicism. In a place like Prince of Peace, where we take all of that very seriously, there is no shortage of men coming to Mass, confession and being active disciples.

The spiritual health of our men is extremely important. The husbands and fathers of present and future have an incredible ability to shape others' lives. Since men also play such a large leadership role in all aspects of society, their physical, emotional and spiritual well-being is crucial to the well-being of everyone. I have found that, often, men's lives begin to break down when they feel that they have been a failure at life. Men wander off the ranch usually when they are stressed out and think that they are failing at being a protector and provider. They then seek solace in sports, alcohol and drugs, pornography or illicit sexual activity, and that self-medication can often lead to them spiraling out of control. Broken men, broken marriages and broken families often result.

The Church has to offer a model of masculinity that is not rooted in toxic historically or culturally conditioned roles, but in the revealed truth of the Word of God, in Jesus Christ as perfect God and perfect man, and in the life of holiness. We are not disembodied creatures. God created us male or female, and we experience everything as gendered persons. The Church has to respond to the real spiritual needs that men have, as men, as husbands, and as fathers, not just generically as Christians. Men's Bible studies, the Knights of Columbus and those growing networks of good male friendships that are part of our POP experience are powerful ways of connecting men to God and each other. To see men and boys praying together on the altar is a powerful witness to all of us. Men are never more noble and strong than when they are on their knees in adoration of their Creator.

But men also need resources to grow spiritually, and those resources have to be accessible where men are. www.menriseup.org is an apostolate of Chris Stefanick and Bill Donaghy, who have spent a lot of time in the lay apostolate of the Church with men and women of all ages. The website has a sign up for videos as well as a challenge to form small communities of men to mentor and accompany each other. It also provides a number of links to conferences and other websites which can provide spiritual nourishment. Our men lead busy lives, and they often seek guidance for what is healthy and good for them. I urge our men (and womenfolk, too!) to check out this website today and see what might be helpful to you!





rcia celebration






