# From our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

At Prince of Peace, we often talk about Latin, which is the official language of the Catholic Church. We have a Latin Mass every day, except during the summer and the octaves of Christmas and Easter. What you might not know is that, there were calls for Catholic worship in the vernacular already in the 16th century, and that permission for Mass in the vernacular was given to some Catholics in Chinese, Huron, and Glagolitic before permission was extended for greater use of the vernacular in the 1960s.

When the Church gave the green light for the vernacular to go alongside Latin (not replace it, which happened in some places) at that time, the question rose: how do we translate the texts of the Mass? In 1969, the Vatican issued a document called *Comme le prevoit*, which enshrined the principle of *dynamic equivalence*, namely, that translations should keep the sense of the vernacular with a view to the cultural needs of those hearing the texts. The problem was that many translations took so many liberties with the text that they became unrecognizable as translations of the original Latin. In 2001, the Vatican issued another set of guidelines called *Liturgicam authenticam*, which called for more literal and faithful renderings of the official Latin texts.

We saw the fruit of that document in 2011 with the publication of the new English translation of the Ordinary Form missal. It is a great improvement over the previous translation, but it has come at a learning curve for all of us. One of the main controversies that has ensued over it is this: should our common worship “sound” like everyday English or something more elevated? There is a lot of discussion today about the concept of “hieratic” or “sacred” vernacular.

I grew up with the King James Version of the Bible, so as a child, I learned the Word of God and how to pray to God in Jacobean English. That’s why the cadences and obsolete grammatical structures of archaic English, I can wrap my tongue around without it seeming like I’m in a Monte Python skit. But that’s not everyone’s experience. Living languages are living, and so rendering the texts of prayer in them is an art, which in the Catholic Church we are still perfecting. In a previous life, I worked as a translator, doing written and simultaneous oral translations between English, Spanish, Portuguese, French and Italian. It was fun work, but challenging. I can’t imagine the responsibility of doing that work for the sacred liturgy. Msgr Ronald Knox, whose translation of the Bible into English is one of those versions people either love or hate, wrote a fascinating book called *Englising the Bible*. These questions are very important, and endlessly interesting.

The Spring 40 Days for Life Campaign **made an impact** saving 645 lives (confirmed) - 1 of which was in Greenville. Abortions in South Carolina in 2017 declined 10% from the previous year according to provisional data from the South Carolina Department of Health & Environmental Control.
