


mini-retreat registration open

40 days for life—spring campaign results

The Spring 40 Days for Life Campaign made an impact saving 645 lives (confirmed) - I of which was in Greenville. Abortions in South Carolina in 2017 declined 10% from the previous year according to provisional data from the South Carolina Department of Health & Environmental Control. All 3 freestanding abortion facilities lost business in the state of SC with Greenville Women's Clinic losing about 5% (per South Carolina Citizens for Life). 


