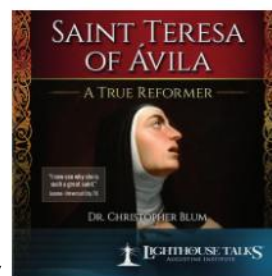

About the content: Into the Breach is a program sponsored nationally by the Knights of Columbus in cooperation with Bishop Olmsted. It stresses the essential nature of fatherhood and grandfather-hood and it outlines a battle plan for apostolic action.
