

Dear Friends in Christ,

I have always been a bit reticent to address issues related to modesty in church, but not out of cowardice! When people truly understand what they are doing at Holy Mass, they tend to dress and act appropriately. Harping on external codes of dress and behavior can come across as precisely the legalistic, judgmental Church that we actually are not. If we put the cart before the horse, then we can lose opportunities for evangelization by insisting that the external manifest the internal before that interior life is truly there to shape and model the exterior. I remind people that we have to think like missionaries, and that requires patience. Also, while there are some pretty universal norms about what is appropriate in certain places and what is not, there are historical and cultural aspects to the question as well. There is no "one size fits all" when it comes to dress at Mass. I have been in communities with some of the wealthiest people in the country and some of the poorest. What drove them to wear appropriate dress at Mass was not some guideline published by Father, but what they truly thought about the Eucharist.

On the other hand, we live in an age which is incredibly informal. An old saying goes, familiarity breeds contempt. So people shrug their shoulders and say, "I don't think God cares what you wear, as long as you are there." They have obviously never read the Book of Leviticus, where God puts down minute prescriptions on how He wanted to be worshipped and even what priests were to wear. I know that sometimes life takes over, and you and your family just have to get to Mass, and you come as you are. I get that. And I am also aware that we should be careful from making too many assumptions and judging people as to why they do what they do. I've put my foot in my mouth before about that!

Americans are often surprised and angry when they go to Rome and are not allowed in St Peter's or some of the other churches, because they are in shorts, tank tops, see through clothes, etc. In Europe is not uncommon to see large signs outside churches of permitted and forbidden clothing items that look like TSA security announcements at the airport. They are shocked that they are required to put on shawls or hospital pants before being allowed inside. I think that should cause us to stop and reassess: if it's good enough for the Pope in Rome, should we not be at least thinking the same things?

As a child, we were raised that God's house was sacred, and that a Christian showed respect by silence in church, and being dressed properly. For my family, that meant a coat and tie, dress slacks and dress shoes. Did I hate it as a child? Absolutely. Did I moan and groan and fight over it? Yep. Did my parents ever throw up their hands and say, "Forget it!" No. Not once. Ever. The principle of instilling respect, reverence and decorum was too important as a life skill and as a sign of religious faith. And that was in a Baptist church, which was basically just a large auditorium.

Our churches are dwelling places for the Most High; they are the antechamber to heaven itself. The most important preparation we can make for the Lord's Day celebration is to make sure our baptismal robe of grace is unstained by sin, by frequent confession. But we also must take care not to distract others or ourselves, by dressing in a manner which does not show forth that we know that we are doing is special. That doesn't mean you have to bring the prom dress or the tuxedo out for Mass, but it does mean that we should prepare for Mass as if preparing for something amazing. Because we always are!
