Dear Friends in Christ,

Years ago, Catholic parishes in our country had a church building where the priests celebrated sacraments, a school and a convent of nuns to take care of the children, and maybe a gym or a hall where parishioners gathered for sports and social events. The staff may have also had an organist and a secretary, and that's about it. Nowadays, the armies of priests and nuns are no more. And people have very much increased expectations about programming, activities and ministries in their parishes. Add to that facilities maintenance, technology upgrades, insurance, and the need to pay lay workers a living and just wage commensurate with their experience, education and job descriptions!

Prince of Peace has become an incredibly busy place as of late. This is a sign of God's blessing on our parish family, but with those blessings comes responsibility. We must be careful to administer wisely your investment in your parish. The Finance Council and the Staff are always trying to make the best decisions in that regard. But we also have to grow our resources to match the incredible growth in demand. We have no other source of funding except you! Sometimes people assume that the Bishop and the Diocese give us money. The Feast of the Assumption is celebrated every year on 15 August to honor the immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, who was assumed body and soul to heavenly glory! This is a **Holy Day of Obligation**, designating this feast day as one which is very important and on which we are to celebrate at Mass with all the angels & saints!

Mass times: 7a, 8.30a, 12p (Latin) and 7p

At the 12n & 7p Mass: According to ancient tradition, when Mary's earthly life ended, the Apostles, who were scattered over the earth were miraculously brought together in Jerusalem. Upon opening her tomb for veneration, the apostles discovered her body was gone and a sweet odor permeated the space with wild flowers growing out of the stone sarcophagus in which she had been laid. In honor of this last part of the story, the Church instituted the custom of **blessing wild herbs and flowers** on the feast of the Assumption. The blessing originated in Germany, and is first attested in the 10th century. We encourage all the faithful to bring with them herbs and cultivated or wild flowers for a blessing! When you arrive, place them at Our Lady Queen of Peace Altar.




