

From Our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

Every once in while I hear the old canard, “But, Father, Vatican II abolished Latin in the Mass. Why do we still sing in Latin here at Prince of Peace?” I really do not know where this comes from, but it’s useful every once in a while to review what the Fathers of the Second Vatican Council actually said about the subject. In 1963, the Fathers approved the magna carta of the liturgy at Vatican II, a document called Sacrosanctum concilium. What does this important conciliar constitution, which guides the life of the Church’s worship still today, actually say about Latin and the Mass?

SC 36: “The use of the Latin language is to be preserved in the Latin rites.”

SC 54: “Steps should be taken so that the faithful may also be able to say or to sing together in Latin those parts of the Ordinary of the Mass which pertain to them.”

SC 116: “The Church acknowledges Gregorian chant as specially suited to the Roman liturgy: therefore, other things being equal, it should be given pride of place in liturgical services.”

SC 115: “Great importance is to be attached to the teaching and practice of music in . . . Catholic institutions and schools. To impart this instruction, teachers are to be carefully trained and put in charge of the teaching of sacred music . . . Composers and singers, especially boys, must also be given a genuine liturgical training.”

In 1967, the Vatican issued an instruction called *Musicam sacram*, which explained further in detail how the provisions of Vatican II on the liturgy should be implemented musically:

MS 5: “Liturgical worship is given a more noble form when it is celebrated in song, with the ministers of each degree fulfilling their ministry and the people participating in it. Indeed, through this form, prayer is expressed in a more attractive way, the mystery of the liturgy, with its hierarchical and community nature, is more openly shown, the unity of hearts is more profoundly achieved by the union of voices, minds are more easily raised to heavenly things by the beauty of the sacred rites, and the whole celebration more clearly prefigures that heavenly liturgy which is enacted in the holy city of Jerusalem. Pastors of souls will therefore do all they can to achieve this form of celebration.”

MS 18: “The formation of the whole people in singing, should be seriously and patiently undertaken together with liturgical instruction, according to the age, status and way of life of the faithful and the degree of their religious culture; this should be done even from the first years of education in elementary schools.”

MS 27: “For the celebration of the Eucharist with the people, especially on Sundays and feast days, a form of sung Mass (*Missa in cantu*) is to be preferred as much as possible, even several times on the same day.”

MS 33: “It is desirable that the assembly of the faithful should participate in the songs of the Proper as much as possible, especially through simple responses and other suitable settings.”

At Prince of Peace, we have an incredible tradition of choral music executed at a very high level from the treasury of sacred music from all times. We also have a chance to hand on that classical liturgical and musical tradition, first of all by congregational singing of Latin parts of the Mass and English propers and hymns, and second of all by instruction in both Latin and music in our school and educational programs. The Church asks us to do this, so let’s get to it!






