



Dear Friends in Christ,

Last week I wrote about trends in dogmatic theology which are at the root of much of the present crisis in the Church. Today, I want to talk about similar trends in moral theology. The question: how we are to live a moral life? is a perennial one of both philosophy and theology. In the late Middle Ages, there was already a split between two camps: one said that we discover the moral law from the nature that God fashioned all things; the other, that it is not from nature, but merely from the will of God, who could have decreed things to be other than they are. The first school can not envision a lie being anything other than a lie; the second could see God making a lie into truth by His command. In later centuries, theologians developed a case-based approach to the moral life which sought to apply universal norms to particular situations. This science of casuistry led to two attitudes: I) what can I get away with and not sin? And 2) doesn't the moral life depend, not on universal norms, but the situation in which I find myself.

The problem with casuistry is that it led to a minimalist and legalistic approach to the moral life as opposed to grounding moral life in the cultivation of virtue and grace to a fuller life in Christ. When confronted with the philosophical issues of the Enlightenment, Modernism and contemporary philosophy, casuistry degenerated into two schools of thought: proportionalism and situation ethics. Both schools placed in our own subjective reasoning about any specific situation the place of moral reasoning. St John Paul II reacted very strongly against these trends in Catholic theology in Fides et ratio and Veritatis splendor by arguing for an objective moral order based on natural law and revelation, and how a life of virtue and grace lived to its fullest in Christ was the way to authentic human flourishing and salvation.

Catholic academia did not respond universally well to this teaching of the Magisterium. Ever since Paul VI's bombshell encyclical *Humanae vitae* in 1968, many professional theologians and clergy had adopted a position of active dissent and defiance of the Magisterium of the Church in her rejection of moral relativism and embrace of virtue-based ethics. A new casuistry became prevalent in preaching, teaching and spiritual direction, which paid lip service to the official teaching but which steadily advanced its undermining.

The current crisis we are facing as a Church is due in no small part to generations of Church leaders, both lay and clerical, who have stayed in their positions while not believing in their hearts and minds that what the Church says is true. They wanted to work from the inside to change the Church to deny her own teaching and embrace moral relativism.

That is why it is important to understand what the Church teaches and why. I encourage you to take up these encyclicals of John Paul II and the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* and struggle with the teaching. Rejecting that teaching puts us in dead ends, and has disastrous consequences for our life together as a Christian family. The crisis of dissent is bearing putrid fruit in our own time. Now we can and should learn what the Church teaches and why, so we can bear good fruit!




