

# An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

#### Dear Friends in Christ,

We knew when we built our church 16 years ago that this was a building which would be added to for generations to come. The vessels, vestments and artwork that have been given to the parish is part of the cultural and artistic patrimony of the parish, and is a powerful testament to the generosity of those who believe in the power of beauty to transform souls. Since I have gotten here, most of what we have done is add small ticket items to what we have: vestments, vessels, the canopies and railings for the side altars, candlesticks and candelabrae, reliquaries, etc. The renewal of the Adoration Chapel was perhaps the most significant change we have seen, and I was impressed by the incredible generosity of our people in providing worthy items for the chapel.

We will, of course, continue to add to those things as the years pass by. Right now, the bigger ticket items are very much on hold. We have so much to do with what we have now that to start any big projects will entail significant fundraising for new things. But, that doesn't mean we shouldn't have them on our radar screen. Or, for you to consider planned giving for your estate to fund some of those things!

What are some of the big-ticket items for the church that I think really need to be done?

- I. When the church was built, the concrete floor was never stained or sealed. This is a nightmare for preservation, cleaning and aesthetics. This is a time consuming and expensive project which would mean time outside of the church, as well!
- 2. When they installed the lights in the apse, little thought was given to how to change the light bulbs effectively and easily. We need to address this and the lighting in the church with new technology, but you would be amazed at the expense!
- 3. A pipe organ configured to the liturgical and musical requirements of our parish tradition.
- 4. Murals in the apse and the arches over the transepts. The sheer size of these spaces and the need for good art would mean a significant investment.
- 5. The sacristy is much too small for what we do in it, and there is no bathroom for the clergy.
- 6. Stained glass in the choir loft to beautify the church and decrease the glare on the altar
- 7. A mosaic on the front of the church above the door of the Prince of Peace, and a cross on the top of the church.

I wanted to share these things with you because I think it is important for us to be aware of the things that we do need to go the next level for our church building. And, so that if you win the lottery, you know what to play for!





This devotion is one of the principal points of the Fatima message. It centers on the urgent need for mankind to offer reparation and expiate for the many injuries that the Immaculate Heart of Mary suffers from the hands of both impious and indifferent men. To help you fulfill this request made by Our Lady of Fatima, plan to attend our First Saturday Masses on October 6, November 3, December 1, January 5, February 2, March 2, April 6, and May 4.
