From our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

I have been noticing a lot of new people at Mass in the past few weeks. Some of you have come to introduce yourselves to me, and for that I am most grateful. It's always great to meet new people and get to know them better. For those of you who haven't waited in the line to see Father after Mass yet, if you are new to Prince of Peace, I would love to put the face with the name.

Being new to a parish is one of those things that different people handle differently. Some people like to be as invisible as possible until they feel comfortable talking to someone and putting their little toe in the pool of greater involvement. Then there are those who start flying the POP flag as soon as they drive up to the campus and dive in to everything they can as soon as they can. Most of us are in the middle.

What does it mean to be a welcoming parish? As Catholics, we are often ambivalent about intentionally creating a welcoming environment. There's part of this that I think is kind of awesome, actually. As Catholics, we are at home at any Catholic parish in the world, and we can walk into any house of worship and know we are at home, and so we don't have to go to extreme lengths to make people feel welcome in what is already their home. At the same time though, every individual parish community has its own history, identity, quirks and dynamic, and I think we do have to be intentional about encouraging newcomers to engage all of that. What I am skeptical of is the kind of welcoming which means gimmicky stuff at Mass, or people you don't know acting like they're your long lost chum/BFF to hook you into some ministry or another. There should be a naturalness to what we do.

If you see someone down the pew from you that you haven't seen before, please introduce yourself discreetly to them, and help them out if they seem like they need a warm welcome. Smile at them! And for the love of all that is holy, don't make them climb over you to get into the pew! A little goes a long way! Our Welcoming Committee, the Guild of St Benedict, is always at the ready to make Prince of Peace a wonderful place to come home to.

For those of you who are new to the traditional way in which we celebrate Holy Mass, there is a great guide in the pew that give some background to practices with which you may not be as familiar. We've even had visitors come here and comment on how beautiful the Mass was and take the guide home to their parish priests! And we have also had people come and be totally freaked out by what we do as well: for many, it is like stepping back in time. Some like that, and others hate it. For me, it's like stepping into a place which is timeless. The reverent celebration of the Roman liturgy takes us through the ages of history backwards, and forwards, to the source and summit, the alpha and omega, of all our Christian life: Jesus!

It is so good to see so many new people, and a consoling thing to see the same beautiful faces week in and week out. What a community of faith to truly belong to, a spiritual home which is ours!




