

Dear Friends in Christ,

I know it may be hard to believe, but I was a layman once, many years ago. And, I remember going to church by myself. Since my family wasn't Catholic, I was the only one to go to church, and it wasn't until later that I had friends to go to Mass with. Many of our regular Sunday Massgoers come to Mass by themselves. I was usually okay with it, and then went about my day. But, one thing that made it nice was that I often had friends who invited me for Sunday lunch or dinner with them. I had Catholic families often with lots of children, who adopted me as one of their own, and always had me around to lunch or dinner. On Sundays, this was very crucial.

Sunday is the Lord's Day, and it is a family day, a fun day for rest and relaxation as well as worship. Do you celebrate it as a joyful occasion? And, do you invite others to participate in that rejoicing? I think we have many people in our parish who go to Mass and then go home alone to eat and spend the rest of the day by themselves. Sometimes that is just what the doctor ordered, but sometimes it can be quite lonely. I want to challenge our families: have you gotten to know someone in the parish who comes to Mass by themselves and invited them to Sunday brunch with your family? People who come to Mass by themselves, have you invited someone else you see for coffee after Mass or for a quick bite to eat afterwards.

The central act of worship of the Christian faith is a meal: sharing a table is part of the mix, and enjoying food and fellowship flows from the church into the world. In the Oratorian tradition, they used to say that the refectory is an extension of the sanctuary. The dining room is a flowing forth from church. Putting out the best linens, silverware, china to celebrate the Lord's Day, observing rituals of welcome, prayer and thanksgiving: what a way to make Sunday special.

I have been watching a TV show on Amazon called *Srugim*, about Orthodox Jewish thirty-somethings who are all single, looking for spouses, living in Jerusalem. They are all trying to live a religious life while being in the world, and much of it reminds me of how challenging it is to stay focused. I love watching their commitment to the Sabbath, and it makes me think we need to recover the Lord's Day in a more intentional matter. Every episode has a *Shabbat* meal, and while every meal also has serious personal drama, it is also part of a lifestyle of worship and obedience to God's commands. Let's reclaim Sunday again! Mass, good meals, welcoming others, Vespers, fun and relaxation: and set aside all of the worldly stuff for Monday.




