A letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

You may have noticed in the church a small new icon of a young Black man and wondered, "Who is this?" A missionary order called the White Fathers, because of their white religious habits, made the first inroads at evangelizing in Uganda. One of their first converts was a servant in the royal household named Charles Lwanga. His physical and moral beauty and strength were remarked on by everyone, and he rose through the ranks to become the head of the pages who served the king. The pagan king, Mwanga, pretended to be interested in Christianity until he was convinced that the new converts were just pawns of foreign rulers. His insatiable appetite for lust was brought to bear on his pages, who ranged in age from 13 to 30. Charles did everything he could to protect these young men from a manipulative and lecherous ruler. For resisting his evil advances, Mwanga ordered Charles and 22 of his Catholic and Anglican servants to be burned alive on 3 June 1886. They became martyrs for their Christian faith and for the virtue of purity. On 22 June 1964, Pope St Paul VI canonized Charles Lwanga and his Companions, the first martyrs of Sub-Saharan Africa, in what would be the last celebration of the old Papal Rite before the reforms of Vatican II changed it.

In our own time, we have seen how powerful people have forced all manner of sexual and gender ideologies on our young people. We have also seen the terrible results of the sexual abuse of children in society and even in our Church, and the cover ups of those who were responsible for protecting the innocence and purity of the vulnerable. St Charles Lwanga was a new convert to Christ and the fullness of the Catholic Faith, who bravely stood up against the most powerful man of the land to protect children and young people from the abuse of power and to protect their faith and their purity. He is a powerful example to us that we must be ready even to suffer to provide for our young people to thrive in a safe environment where they may know they are truly loved by God and by us. He is a model of courage, perseverance and manhood, whose virtues of fortitude, prudence and chastity can inspire all of us. Because both Catholics and Anglicans were martyred together, it is also a powerful witness that the martyrdom of blood can help us to appreciate authentic ecumenism of Christian witness, where disunity among Christians is overcome by the beauty of holiness.

We have many people in our world who struggle with the aftermath of physical, sexual and emotional abuse, with temptations of lust and power, and with a desire for the Church to become once again a beacon of light, love and courage in resisting all evils against the dignity of the human person and love. I think that St Charles Lwanga and his companions can be brave friends on our way through this valley of tears to heaven itself.


