A letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

I arrived at Prince of Peace seven years ago this month with a definite vision about what our parish could be become. Pope Benedict XVI, who was still reigning gloriously on the Throne of the Fisherman, had proposed that the two forms of the Roman Rite, the Ordinary Form and the Extraordinary Form, could mutually enrich each other. He also had as part of his papal magisterium the idea that the reforms of Vatican II had to be interpreted in continuity with, and not in rupture against the historical tradition of the Roman Church. And so I set about to model our parish life in all of its particulars on that vision: continuity with tradition, while being open to what is true, good and beautiful in the new. We are our rites, and so I insisted on the restoration of the sacred to our liturgy. These elements were all part of our parish life already, but I wanted to see our little part of the vineyard flourish as a center for authentic Catholic culture.

Our parish staff and numerous volunteers, some of whom have moved away to do great work elsewhere, have worked tirelessly to implement this vision. We have rethought every aspect of ministry and Christian formation from womb to tomb, and I am very proud of what we have accomplished and continue to work on. We have had people literally move from across the country to be a part of this amazing place. (Now truth be told, there are also Catholics who live right across the street for whom POP is not their cup of tea, but they have also found their own spiritual homes, too!)

I have mightily resisted the idea of the parish as a cafeteria where people pick and choose what they like of doctrine, spirituality and programming, where ministries are multiplied just to give people something to do. Instead, we have charted a course where the parish is the powerhouse where we come to be formed and nourished spiritually, sacramentally, artistically, and intellectually, so we can then go to do the work of the Lord out in the world.

We have also had some significant challenges during these seven years: transitioning from a bare-bones maintenance to a mighty mission mindset with our facilities, all of which need upgrading; growing our stewardship to match the demands of our people for staff and programs to support the vision; and transforming the school from an independent-acting body to an authentic ministry of the parish, formed by the same vision of excellence as the parish. All the grey hair I have gotten since 2011 has come from the complexity of implementing those needed changes, and I haven't always gotten it right! But when you see what we have built here together, not just since 2011 but since 1974, it's pretty incredible!

This Christmas, I want to reveal to you my greatest goals for the next seven years: I want us to focus so much on evangelization and outreach, all the while deepening our relationship with Christ and our immersion in Catholic culture, that we:

- grow our average Sunday Mass attendance from 1413 to 2402 (that's a 70% increase, a tenth for every one of the next seven years),
- grow our school to 220 students (20 students in each grade from K3-8)
- grow our RE enrolment to 300 students
- grow our weekly offertory to \$35,000 a week
- complete an upgrade of all our facilities to current standards, and provide storage for so many things we need

That's not a lot, is it? I didn't know seven years ago what an incredible place we would be in 2018, yet here we are. I wish all of you a very merry ChristMass, and know that you and your enthusiasm for the Church are the greatest gift you give to me!

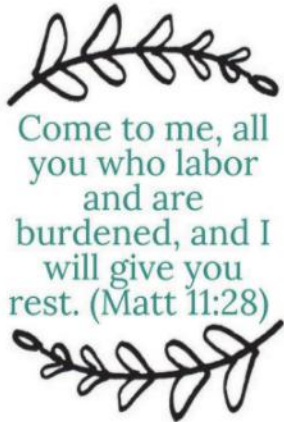

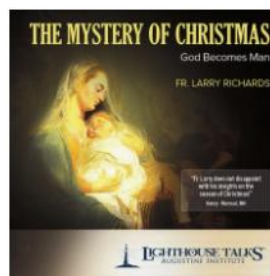

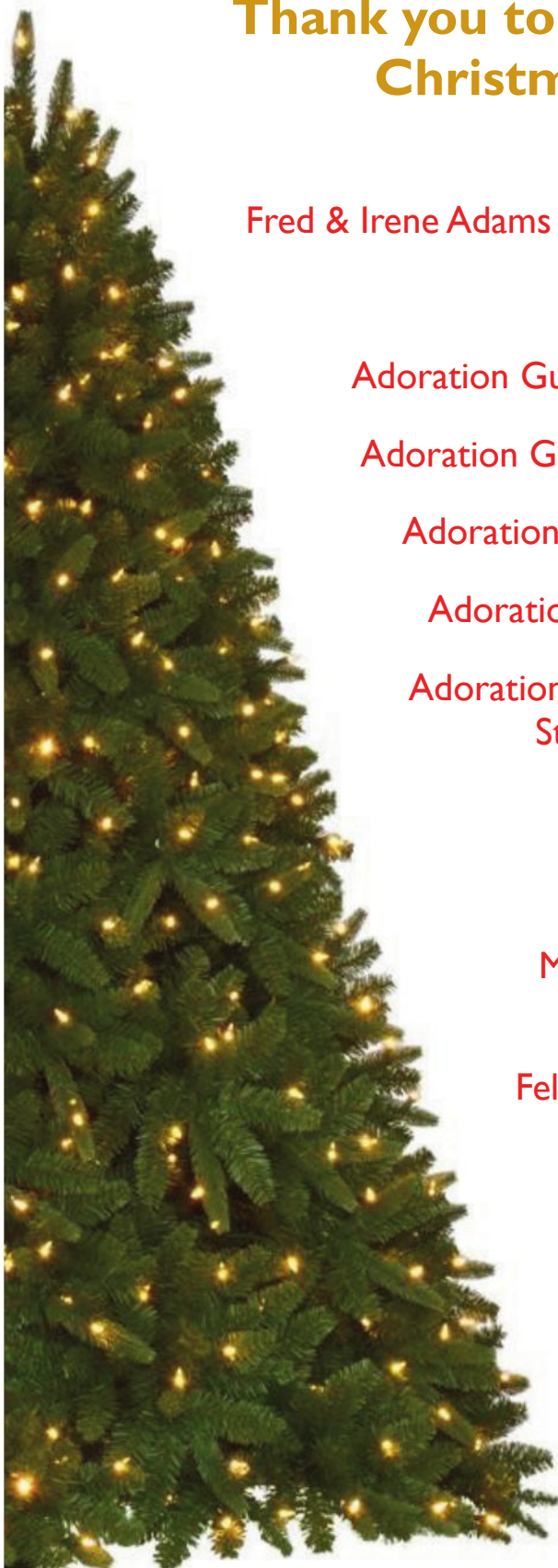
