

## An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

Everybody wants change, but no one wants to change. There are many people who have a problem for every solution. Now, don't get me wrong, it is important to think intelligently and prudently through the potential drawbacks to any situation or proposal. But more often than not, we let fear and comfort keep us from achieving great things. New Year's is full of resolutions that end up in empty promises by February. Think about how many gyms run according to a business model of all of those people who sign up and pay for memberships and then never come, keeping overhead pretty low! We are afraid to do hard things, to launch out in the unknown and put ourselves out there, because: What if it doesn't work? What if I am rejected or abandoned or betrayed? What if I am in over my head?

The spiritual life is a journey, but it is decidedly not a leisurely stroll through a field of dreams. While the spiritual life is first of all an encounter with Christ's unmerited grace, it also requires, not just our cooperation, but our effort, dedication and hard work. You may never be an Olympic weightlifter, but you do owe it to the temple of the Holy Spirit that is your body to exercise and diet well. Likewise, you may think you will never be an athlete of Christ, canonized with statues to you in churches all over the world. But you do owe it to your creator to worship Him, your redeemer to proclaim the Good News to others, and your sanctifier to make use of all of the tools the Church gives you to pursue a meaningful life of holiness.

I have been doing a lot of reading lately about what develops mental and physical toughness and strength in elite military, athletic and business overachievers. What is so surprising is that, although some have incredible gifts of nature, many attribute their success to the relentless pursuit of excellence. When we let negative thinking cloud our thoughts, or sinful behaviors to warp our desires, we lose out on so many opportunities for growth and beauty. Don't look at your nature, or yourself, as less than anyone or anything else. You are perfect (well, perfect-ish) the way you are, made in the image and likeness of God. But don't stay there, because you won't actualize a potential of infinite yearning towards divinity itself! God knew what He was doing when He made you, and He calls you to be infinitely more than that. We may be all different vessels, but each of us is capable of being overflowing with gifts of grace that far outweigh any gifts of nature.

Letting the Holy Spirit take control of your life is anything but passive. Be intentional about engaging all of those spiritual disciplines which train us to be the best we can be. Delve into your chosen state in life with joy and abandon, even when it is hard. Make your work not just an opportunity for a paycheck, but a place of sanctification and evangelization by example.

You were set on fire with Holy Ghost power at your baptism and confirmation. If you feel that fire getting dim or cool, it doesn't have to be that way. Schedule an hour of Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament today. Consider going to Daily Mass at least once a week. Pray the Rosary and/or the Divine Office every day. Compose a Rule of Life with some definite form of penance and mortification every week. Plan your finances around God's tithe for parish, bishop and charity. There's so much to do that can bring about real change, not just ourselves, but the whole world. So let's do it!
