A letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

The earliest clear reference to the Feast of the Epiphany was in AD 361, but there are echoes of a celebration with that theme as early as 200. Christmas as a feast was first recorded at Rome in 336, but there are indications as early as AD 70 of a commemoration on 25 December as the birth of the Savior. In the East, however, Epiphany was generally considered to be a theological feast exploring the Nativity, the Visit of the Wise Men, the Baptism of Our Lord by St John the Baptist in the River Jordan, and the Miracle at the Wedding at Cana. Only later was the Nativity separated out in the East as its own feast. In the West, Christmas did not gain much prominence until Charlemagne's coronation on that day in 800, and the Frankish emperor made it into a thing all over his dominions. But in both East and West, the Epiphany, with its celebrations of the manifestations of Jesus' divinity, was the religious focal point of the winter season.

In the West, even though the liturgy made reference to the various manifestations of Christ's divinity, it became concentrated on the visit of the Wise Men. In fact, in many Catholic cultures, gift giving was reserved to what became known as the Twelfth Night of Christmas. In the 1950s, Pope Pius XII established a separate feast for the Baptism of the Lord, further disassociating the themes of the Epiphany from one another. The various feasts become less a unity of theological significance and more separate historical commemorations of events. This reordering of the Christmas feasts was a bow to a long process by which, in many places, Christmas had become more important than the Epiphany anyway.

Pope Pius XII also abolished the Octave of the Epiphany, the eight days of continued meditation on that very rich feast. In 1970, Pope Paul VI decreased the importance of the feast further, by allowing it to be transferred to the nearest Sunday, making it no longer a holy day of obligation in most places, as well as making the time right after it, no longer, *Time after Epiphany*, but *Ordinary Time*. One of the more curious things about the liturgical reform of the 20th century was the almost total annihilation of one of the most important ancient feasts of the Church, whose theological and spiritual wealth had dominated an important part of the sacred year and formed Christian culture for centuries.

But that doesn't mean we can't still celebrate this great feast and the sanctification of the time around it as richly as possible. Perhaps a fruitful subject of meditation is how Jesus' divinity has manifested itself in our lives? How do we show forth Jesus by living our baptismal vows? How do we turn the water of nature into the wine of grace through the sacramental life of marriage? How do we worship at the Crib with the same awe and love that the Magi paid to Jesus?




