Dear Friends in Christ,

Sometimes people wonder why I do not address certain current events at Mass, especially when they are controversial and touch upon the faith. I made a decision many years ago to be very disciplined about when I would speak and why. For most people, the only time they ever hear their priest speak is at the pulpit in the homily, and they may read (during the homily, ahem) the bulletin column. But the sermon's purpose is to break open the Word of God and to instruct the faithful on faith and morals. Now, not a few of the issues of the day touch upon faith and morals. And people want the homily to be relevant to their lives.

But, I also do not want to reduce the priestly ministry to being just another talking head in your lives. The priest's job is to teach, to govern and to sanctify, but we can also exhaust our capital pretty quickly with folks if they are not open to receiving what we have to say. That is why I think we must be very disciplined in our speech, so that when we speak directly to a topic, it is more likely to be heard and internalized. If we turn the homily into "What does Father think about this week's insane crisis?", that might make me a shock jock personality some souls would appreciate, but not into someone pointing to wisdom beyond all of us.

That is why I often use history or the lives of the saints to illustrate a dogmatic or moral point. They have relevance today, as well, we just have to apply the wisdom of the Bible and the Church. While I am flattered that so many people care what I think and have to say, it is crucial for me to keep my opinions about prudential things or unfolding events to myself, for the greater good of having more weight when I do directly address certain things.

There is a type of silence or discretion which is abusive, manipulative and destructive. But there is also a silence and discretion which shows spiritual maturity, charity and a desire to be effective and helpful. Where that attitude is missing, we add fuel to fires, allow people to drag us into endless debates which manufacture outrage, and rarely bring us to a brighter, happier world. Social media has given us unforeseen platforms for free speech. But that has not made us mature and responsible, or humble and discerning in our speech. I like to talk, a lot, and I have all kinds of opinions about all kinds of things. As I get older, I am more reserved about sharing those thoughts, which endlessly frustrates some people, especially when they're looking for a fight, or to dismiss what I have to say. I think it important for the clergy to share less what they think about any given subject, and more important to share what the Word of God has to say about every subject. Pure, unvarnished, uninterpreted: unleash wisdom on the world, and let truth do its thing.





family honor

One of the most merciful acts you can do as a Catholic in today's culture is speak the truth in love about chastity, marriage and family. But how to begin? 
