A letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

Words mean something. When we use words, or misuse them, omit them or exaggerate them, we all say something about what our intention is when we formulate sounds with our mouths that correspond to a certain meaning. Like many of you, I have been absolutely horrified by the fact that states are voting to legalize practical infanticide. While terms like *fetus* and *embryo* have meaning, they have been manipulated in such a way for so many decades to imply that there is something a little bit “less than” about human beings in those stages of development. When we vote for public officials who do not respect the fundamental right to life, thinking that by doing so we are gaining in other areas, we shouldn’t be surprised when politicians subvert the rights of the most defenseless.

One of the corollaries of the recent New York decision to allow abortion up until birth is that life in the womb has lost a protection. Before this, if a woman carrying a baby in her womb was killed or punched, it was a grave crime against two people. Now, the gravity of the crime has been lessened, and it is no longer considered a crime against two people. When we allow words to be manipulated, and laws changed to reflect anti-life priorities, we go down a rabbit hole of insanity that we never know what we are going to see the end of.

Marriage. Gender. Masculinity. These words, and the realities behind them, are seeing a deliberate transformation by people with agendas who deny the reality behind them, in order to change them. Even the revolutionaries often do not foresee the consequences of where this process leads. But this is often the case with revolutions. The people who hanker after radical changes in human nature and society inevitably turn against each other, destabilize society and wreak havoc on the peace and tranquility of everyone in their path. History is replete with examples of how they all end badly, with no small amount of destruction in their path.

You and I can’t stop the march of history. It is what it is. But we can be faithful to truth at all times. Human reason and divine revelation, respect for natural law and handing on the moral precepts of the Gospel are within our power. We are living in a dramatic time where fundamental notions about the human person are under attack, and the social contract which unites our country is fraying. Not to be alarmist, but we must resist with the power of truth set free, and may our words formed in love always carry the weight of conviction!

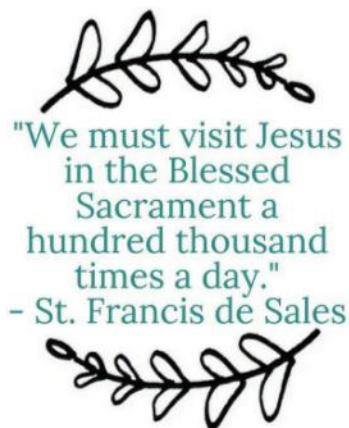

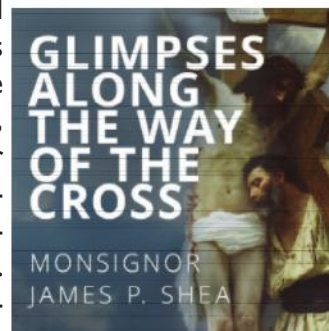
