Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

Tomorrow is the great Feast of the Annunciation, when we celebrate the day that changed the world forever. When the Archangel Gabriel came to the young Mary at her home in Nazareth, he brought tidings of great joy that she was to be the Mother of the Savior. 25 March is of course, nine months from Christmas. It is also near the spring equinox, when day and night are about equal in length. So, the Christian world rejoices in this coming of the light into darkness, a light which will grow into full stature with the Resurrection. In many cultures, today's feast was also the beginning of the civil year. The first month of the Hebrew new year, Nisan, is also right about this time. It marked the time when farmers would often change farms and begin to till the earth at a new place, virgin soil waiting for new life, in honor of Our Lady's yes to the life to end all death. In England, it is traditionally known as Lady Day.



The Feast of the Annunciation was one of 36 Holy Days of Obligation, which were reduced to 8 by St Pius X in 1911. We now only have 6 in the United States: one of those in transferred to Sunday in our province, and all but 2 lose their obligation if they fall on a Monday or a Saturday. It is rather instructive that our sense of rigor and Catholic identity has gone by the wayside. Now, of course, it is also true that we do not live in a country which respects the sacred year in the civil sphere. Even Sunday is being encroached on more and more by the secularizing society around us.

But that doesn't mean that we can't make an extra special effort this year to observe the day that changed history. If you can, please try to make it to Mass: your Mother loves to see you in her Son's house! Celebrate the day with a special festive meal or dessert, since it is a solemnity in the midst of Lent. Pray the Rosary with your loved ones and put together a bouquet of flowers of the rarest to present as a gift before the image of Our Lady in your home.

The prayer most commonly associated with the Annunciation is the Angelus. It is common in Catholic countries for bells to ring at morning, noon and night so that people would stop whatever they were doing to remember this incredible moment. In the school, we have started to teach the children this remarkable prayer. If you don't know it already, you can actually download an app on your phone called "Angelus" with an alarm to help you pray!

Pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts; that we, to whom the incarnation of Christ, Thy Son, was made known by the message of an angel, may by His Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection, through the same Christ Our Lord.


