Letter from Our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

When Father Claude de la Colombière received his first assignment in 1675 after professing solemn vows as a Jesuit to the tiny church of Paray-le-Monial, his friends and family were aghast. What good could come from a place like that? He was also appointed confessor to the Visitation Nuns nearby. It was there that he met Margaret-Mary Alacoque. She had been having visions of the Sacred Heart of Jesus for some time and her fellow sisters tortured her for being a kook. This young nun was at the end of her rope, suffering these supernatural visitations and the constant nastiness of those with whom she was enclosed in the convent. Jesus finally promised to send her a friend, which she needed so badly to survive. When the priest and the nun met, they struck up an intense spiritual friendship, and Father Claude discerned that the visions were authentic.

Margaret-Mary opened her heart to her new priest friend, in whom she had complete confidence. She wrote that he has the spiritual gift “of bringing souls to God along the Gospel way of love and mercy.” Only a year later, though, her friend was sent to the Court of St James in England to be the preacher for Queen Mary of Modena, wife to the Protestant King James II. In a moment of anti-Catholic frenzy, he was arrested and thrown into prison, and was only saved by the direct intervention of King Louis XIV, who was devoted to the priest’s nun best friend and her visions of the Sacred Heart. Their friendship saved his life!

The nun wrote of her visions: “He [Christ] showed me that it was His great desire of being loved by men and of withdrawing them from the path of ruin that made Him want to manifest His Heart to men, with all the treasures of love, of mercy, of grace, of sanctification and salvation which it contains, in order that those who desire to render Him and procure Him all the honor and love possible might themselves be abundantly enriched with those divine treasures of which His heart is the source.” The devotion to the Sacred Heart was propagated throughout the world by the Jesuit order, and has nourished generations of Catholics ever since. The entire month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Alacoque was canonized in 1920; de la Colombière in 1992. The Feast of the Sacred Heart was instituted locally in 1670, and extended to the Universal Church in 1856. The basilica at Paray-le-Monial attracts pilgrims from all over the world. French Catholics, in response to official persecution from their government throughout the 18th and 19th centuries, erected one of the largest churches in the world on top of the highest point in Paris, Sacré Coeur on Montmartre. Perpetual adoration of the Blessed Sacrament has gone on in that place since 1885!

Our Lord’s message of mercy was spread to the world by two unlikely friends, a priest and a nun who embarked on a life of holiness amidst incredible persecution and suffering. Their perseverance has brought the light of Christian joy and beauty to countless people all over the world, who know that God loves them because His heart beats for them at every moment.

Listen to the heart beat of the Savior in your soul and give yourself over to holy friendships and holiness that perseveres through it all. You never know what fruits that can bear for so many!




