Letter from Our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

It's not every day that I come across a story that moves me to tears, but I did recently. Earlier this month, the Diocese of Toulon in France, which regularly produces far more vocations to the priesthood than any other place in France, introduced the cause for beatification for a young child from their Latin Mass personal parish, St François de Paul. Anne-Gabrielle Caron contracted a rare form of bone cancer when she was only seven years old. This affectionate child, a happy Girl Scout, was also rebellious and impatient. As the cancer ravaged her body, and she spent months confined to a hospital bed in Marseilles, she struggled to acquire the virtues that her parish priests spoke about in catechism class.

Anne-Gabrielle received a special grace of understanding that her suffering could be offered up in union with the Passion of Christ, not because she loved the pain she was going through, but because she could be loving to others by that sacrifice. She told her family, "Even though I don't like being sick, I have a chance to help the Good God to bring others to Him. I am jealous of those who suffer and help bring God more Christians."

During this time, two priests who visited her in the hospital regularly helped her family prepare her for First Communion. With the taste of death in her mouth, she was determined to make her First Communion with her RE class. On the Sunday her class was to receive, her doctor released her to go home for a while. Her family was stuck in traffic, trying to get to the Mass, which had already begun, but she prayed fervently. Her family arrived as the Recessional was about to start. She marched right up the central aisle to a seminarian, and said, "I am here to receive Jesus!" and the priest stopped the recessional. Another priest went to the tabernacle as Anne-Gabrielle approached the Communion Rail, and he gave this extraordinary young woman her First Communion as the congregation watched in stunned silence.

She ended up going back to the hospital and spent a month of incredible suffering, asking for forgiveness for her faults, and offering her life as a sacrifice for the patients in the children's hospital. Her intense suffering was made even more so by her constant meditation on the Passion of Christ. After 30 hours of a death agony, offering her suffering for other sick children in the world, the priest who witnessed her passing from this world said, "To see Anne-Gabrielle is to see the face of God."

My friends, Jesus says, *Let the little children come unto Me*. When we surround them with the sacred, with priests, teachers and families who love them, God can raise up the greatest saints among them. I know how hard it is to see anyone suffer, especially children. But God has His own providential plan, and even young children can accomplish that plan by a holiness which illuminates our secular world with the gift of love. Anne-Gabrielle was a difficult child, but her mother, Marie-Dauphine, who wrote a book about her child's remarkable life, saw the peace of God rest upon her whole family through this child.

Always say yes to life. Always say yes to love. Always say yes to Jesus. Always say yes to your children. You never know: you may be present one day when they will be raised to the altars as a model of sanctity and heroic virtue for entire Church on earth, rejoicing with all of the saints and angels in Heaven!

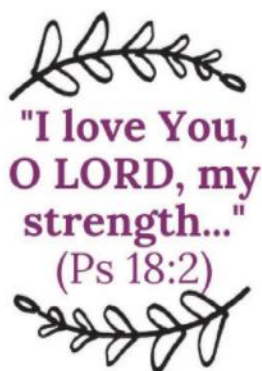

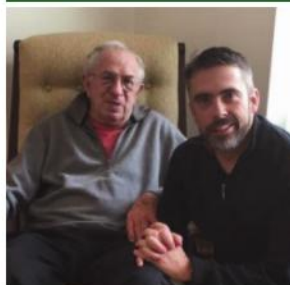

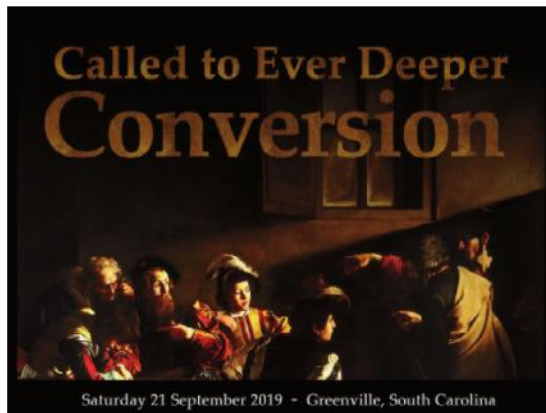
