# Letter from Our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

When a parent says “Yes!” to the gift of life, if they are believers, they present their children at their parish church for Baptism, saying yes to the gift of supernatural life for their children. Parents already answer yes to this question at their marriage in the Church: *Do you resolve to accept children willingly from God and raise them up according to the law of Christ and His Church?* From their first moment (ordinarily) even before they bring a child into this world, a man and woman joined in the sacrament of matrimony promise before God that they will raise their children in the faith. It is the most important responsibility that parents have to hand on the faith they have received and believe to the next generation. Today, we live in an age where many parents spend a lot of time and energy on their children’s physical and intellectual development, but do not always invest the same or more in their spiritual development. They let worldly cares, laziness or ignorance get in the way of this duty.

At Prince of Peace, however, we have a different story to tell. I am continually amazed at how our parents lavish their children with love, and God’s love is part and parcel of that. If anything here, our parents are always looking for ways to increase their faith life in the family, and that enthusiasm makes me so glad to be here! Ordinarily, parents send their children to their closest parish school. Yet, since parents are the primary educators of their children, they sometimes make the decision that is in an individual child’s best interest to homeschool part or all of their education, or to send them to a public or another private school. Either way, they have the right to make that decision, although I would hope that no one would ever choose not to send their child to our school merely because of finances. But there might be other considerations, and we must respect that decision.

From one point of view, an hour a week in RE classes or even five hours a week in school religious instruction is never enough. Those classes are only assisting to the work of the parents in forming the minds of young children to be disciples of Christ. The real work of family faith formation happens in the home. Sometimes parents are looking for more ways they can reinforce at home what is happening in the classroom. We are very blessed to have a strong RE program under Maria Barontini and some incredible catechists. We revamped the program by adopting a new curriculum from Sophia Press this year, and both parents and children in our school and RE programs are benefitting from it.

Investing in RE is a crucial part of the faith formation programs offered by any parish. A fruitful partnership between RE families and parish staff and clergy can yield great benefits for our children, our families and our Church. If you are an adult consider volunteering with our RE program: you could change this world and the next for a child! Please support our RE program in every way you can, and know that, the more support is there, the better our program becomes.


