
Letter from Our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

It is not necessary to teach others, to cure them or to improve them; it is only necessary to live among them, sharing the human condition and being present to them in love.

The man who wrote those words was born into a noble military family in Strasbourg, France in 1858. After he received a large inheritance, he squandered it on debaucheries of various kinds, living the high life as an explorer, soldier and party animal in a way most of us can never even imagine. After a profound conversion experience under the guidance of a celebrated confessor at a church in Paris, he entered the Trappist monastery to live a life of austerity and penance. Always looking to go deeper, and more intensely, Charles de Foucauld went with permission to the Sahara Desert to live as a missionary to the Bedouin tribes. He wanted to found a community of priests, but no one wanted to live like he did, and so he remained almost entirely alone for years, dedicated to prayer and taking care of anyone and everyone who came to his tent.



In 1918, a fifteen-year-old boy shot him in the head, after a frustrated kidnapping attempt. His killer was not found until almost 30 years later, when he was executed for the murder of a priest who had literally fallen off the grid and was unknown to hardly anyone. But his writings, which were filled with such an odor of sanctity, inspired the foundation of a religious community, the Little Brothers of Jesus, who became the companions he always wanted in the desert.

Pope Benedict XVI declared him Blessed in 2005. Charles did not set about to change the world. In fact, he couldn't even get anyone to join him at all as he spent years in obscurity and deprivation in one of the most desolate places on earth. He died a violent and useless death, a senseless crime. But God has used him to inspire countless others to heroically go into places where Christianity has yet to be proclaimed, and to simply be with people so they can see Jesus through them.

Tamanrasset is not quite the same as Taylors. We may be totally unnoticed during what seem to be ordinary lives with a lot of boredom and not a small amount of difficulty. But God is to be found here, as He was to Charles in the Sahara. Don't be afraid to be present in love wherever you are. Don't worry about making this world a better place. If you become a saint, you will!

Jacob kits in our school

Did you know our parish school is outfitted with 30 JACOB Kits, small trauma kits placed within easy access of trained teachers and staff that contain a CAT tourniquet, two chest seals, bandages, trauma shears and medical gloves? All of our staff is trained in stopping bleeds. The trauma kit was named after Jacob Hall, a 6-year-old student wounded in a 2016 school shooting in Townsville, SC. Jacob survived the wound, but died three days later due to massive blood loss. At Prince of Peace, we focus on safety and extend our grateful hearts to the Bobo family, Ryan DeGraw, and the North American Rescue for their work to carefully equip us.
