

Letter from Our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

In 1943, Father Thomas Dade, the chaplain to the Catholic Police and Firemen's Society, celebrated a Mass in honor of first responders and those who have died in the line of duty, at St Patrick's in Washington, DC. The celebration became known as the Blue Mass, since at the time many policemen, firefighters, first responders, and medical professionals wore blue in their uniform. This American tradition has spread to other places in the country, and become an ecumenical event attended every year in Catholic churches. The tradition has also spun off a Red Mass for legal professionals and a White Mass for healthcare professionals.

The first Blue Mass was celebrated on the Feast of St Michael the Archangel, the patron of all who place themselves in harm's way for the common good. As Catholic Christians, we believe that work is a powerful instrument in the sanctification of the faithful. As St Josemaria Escriva said, "Work is part and parcel of man's life on earth. It involves effort, weariness, exhaustion: signs of the suffering and struggle which accompany human exist-



ence, and which point to the reality of sin and the need for redemption. But in itself work is not a penalty or a curse or a punishment (...) work is a gift from God...it makes no sense to classify men differently, according to their occupation, as if some jobs were nobler than others. Work, all work, bears witness to the dignity of man, to his dominion over creation. It is an opportunity to develop one's personality. It is a bond of union with others, the way to support one's family, a means of aiding in the improvement of the society in which we live and in the progress of all humanity."

We are very proud of all of those who labor so intensely for the good of society. This year, St Michael's feast day is a Sunday, and we would like to honor all of those who work as police, firefighters, first responders, as well as health and legal professionals by inviting them to a **Red, White and Blue Mass** on 29 September at 10a at Prince of Peace Catholic Church. We ask that you wear the uniform proper to your office, if appropriate, and after Holy Communion, you will be asked to come forward to receive a special blessing on your work and on your families. The blessing is open to all, and we ask that you invite to Prince of Peace for this special celebration all men and women of good will, Catholic or not, who deserve recognition and blessing for all they do for us!




fraternus news




