

recommended advent reading

Fr Smith's advent reading is Searching for and Maintaining Peace: A Small Treatise on Peace of Heart by Fr Jacques Philippe. It can be purchased for \$7.95 from Amazon.

About the book: We live in an age characterized by agitation and lack of peace. This tendency manifests itself in our spiritual as well as our secular life. In our search for God and holiness, in our service to our neighbor, a kind of restlessness and anxiety take the place of the confidence and peace which ought to be ours. What must we do to overcome the moments of fear and distress which assail us? How can we learn to place all our confidence in God and abandon ourselves into his loving care? This is what is taught in this simple, yet profound little treatise on peace of head. Taking concrete examples from our everyday life, the author invites us to respond in a Gospel fashion to the upsetting situations we must all confront. Since peace of heart is a pure gift of God, it is something we should seek, pursue and ask him for without cease. This book is here to help us in that pursuit.

defending life safely

The recent 40 Days for Life campaign in Greenville was a tremendous success. The need to keep peaceful and prayerful vigil at the Abortion Facility continues to **grow** as prochoice individuals are also now spending time in the same space encouraging mothers to kill their child.

Advice on dealing with counter protesters:

The counter protest is designed to provoke those praying, so do not react in any way to the provocation. Do not return insults. Do not raise one's voice. Do not become angry or aggressive. Do not directly criticize or react to blasphemy or vulgarity. Instead, remain serene, continue to pray, and be respectful at all times of the counter protesters. If these people have indeed been hired to create chaos, then let's deny them the satisfaction of being drawn into their chaos and instead heighten the contradiction between their violence and our peace.

Next, any time there are counter protesters present, someone should be making a video recording of everything on a phone. The one making the recording should not be in the front, but if possible should be standing to one side with a clear view of the faces of the pro abortion group.

If people feel threatened in any way they should call the Sheriff's office: 864.271.5210 option 8. Write about their experience and send it Valerie Baronkin at valeriebaronkin@hotmail.com.

At this time, it is suggest that people do not pray at the abortion facility alone. Bring a partner. Be aware of the situation before bringing children. While some counter protesters have been coming during the week in the morning, the biggest concentration is Saturday morning between 8.30a and 12p.






