# Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

For the past few weeks we have been exploring the heresy of Jansenism. Long after the final condemnation of Jansen by the church, its effects were felt far and wide. Even the Martin family, whose icon greets us at the door of the Quiet Room in the church, was not immune to it. When now saints Louis and Zélie Martin got married, they committed to perpetual abstinence within marriage in order to make sure they did not offend God by the sin of impurity. It was only when their pastor told them that they could be holy and enjoy the marital bed at the same time that they grudgingly put away that lingering puritanism. Thank God they did, because we would never have had St Therese of Lisieux otherwise! Louis was particularly ascetic by temperament and had wanted to be a Trappist monk in a community known for its severe bodily mortifications. Zélie was a practical businesswoman, a working mother, and she checked her husband's defaults to extreme asceticism. Even St Therese was known for somewhat obsessively counting each sacrifice she made, as if somehow to prove to God her worth.



Children who grow up in a household where true zeal is replaced by fanaticism often grow up to reject faith. The Martin household could have become that place, if it weren't for their fervent love of heaven. As St Therese described her parents, "They always talked about heaven as if it were around the corner!" It was this tender, trusting love of Jesus, taught by the Jesuits in the France to counteract the excesses of Jansenism, that brought balance to the Martin household. The family did not take their faith any less seriously; they made the trek on foot to daily Mass at an ungodly early hour every morning, rain or shine. But they took themselves less seriously, and because of that, joy permeated the household even when the difficulties of life (and there were many) were hard to bear. The tender affection and loving attention that Louis and Zélie Martin made the children grow up feeling like princesses in their own very modest home. It's easy to read St Therese and think that she was just way too saccharine and sweet. But in reality, her faithful parents communicated to her such a sense of authentic self-esteem and the royal dignity of baptism, that she remained peaceful and full of vim and vigor even as tuberculosis ravaged her body, and dementia took her beloved father.

Traditional Catholicism in our day is a counter-cultural reaction to the insanity that has invaded our families and public spaces. But when it is not grounded in joy and compassion, the true faith can disintegrate into pharisaical legalism and reworked Jansenism. Yet when it is lived in a peaceful, rational and deeply humble way, the classical Catholic spirituality of the Christian tradition is powerful to move even the most hardened of hearts.

As we celebrate the civic holiday of Thanksgiving this week, I know that some of our families will be intersecting other family members and friends who do not always share our Catholic faith, or not as enthusiastically as we do. Pray that we be delivered from the extremes of blind fundamentalism on the one hand and scandalous laxity on the other, and that our joy and peace may bring hope to every turkey table in Catholic America!



Fr Smith's advent reading is *Searching for and Maintaining Peace: A Small Treatise on Peace of Heart* by Fr Jacques Philippe. It can be purchased for \$7.95 from Amazon.

- **About the book:** We live in an age characterized by agitation and lack of peace. This tendency manifests itself in our spiritual as well as our secular life. In our search for God and holiness, in our service to our neighbor, a kind of restlessness and anxiety take the place of the confidence and peace which ought to be ours. What must we do to overcome the moments of fear and distress which assail us? How can we learn to place all our confidence in God and abandon ourselves into his loving care? This is what is taught in this simple, yet profound little treatise on peace of heart. Taking concrete examples from our everyday life, the author invites us to respond in a Gospel fashion to the upsetting situations we must all confront. Since peace of heart is a pure gift of God, it is something we should seek, pursue and ask him for without cease. This book is here to help us in that pursuit.


