#### An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

Next Sunday is 8 December, and that day is the usual date assigned to the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, nine months before the Nativity of Mary. We are used to it being a Holy Day in the United States of America, because Mary under this title is the patroness of our country. But the intersection of calendar and canonical obligations present some weirdness this year.

Liturgically, in the Ordinary Form the Immaculate Conception is transferred to Monday, 9 December, when 8 December falls on the Second Sunday of Advent. The Ordinary Form does not allow a Marian feast to trump a Sunday of Advent. In the Extraordinary Form, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception replaces the Second Sunday of Advent, so we will still celebrate it on Sunday, 8 December at the I2N Latin Mass and the feria of Advent on 9 December.

Canonically, Catholics in the United States are obliged to assist at Mass on the Immaculate Conception if it is observed on 8 December, even if it is a Monday or a Saturday. But when the feast is transferred to a Monday because it falls on the Second Sunday of Advent, Catholics are released from the obligation.

At Prince of Peace, on Sunday, 8 December we will celebrate Advent II at the English Masses, and Immaculate Conception at the Latin Mass. On Monday, 9 December, we will celebrate the Immaculate Conception at 7a and 7p with English Masses and the feria of Advent II at 12N. You are obliged to come to Mass on Sunday, but not on Monday. We are adding an English Mass on Monday night anyway to celebrate the transferred feast because, well, spiritually, your pastor thinks it's a great idea for all of us to celebrate the Immaculate Conception as a holy day of opportunity even if it is not a holy day of obligation because of the incredibly complicated way our bishops have imposed, transferred and dispensed obligations. And, this is supposed to make our lives easier!

See you next Sunday, and hopefully next Monday, too!



#### 2020 Mass & Confession Schedule

In the Diocese of Charleston, priests in active ministry are entitled every ten years to go on a sabbatical program approved by the Bishop to further their ongoing spiritual and cultural formation. During the sabbatical period, a priest's salary and benefits continue to be paid by the parish, while the expenses of the sabbatical itself are underwritten by the Diocese. We have just celebrated Father Tomlinson's 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary as a priest. The Diocese has given him permission to continue his Biblical studies at Princeton University in New Jersey during a sabbatical period from January to March 2020. I will celebrate 15 years of ordination to the priesthood next July, and the Bishop has given me permission to do my sabbatical from July to December 2020. I will spend three months in Granada, Spain learning Arabic, and the rest of the time at Oxford University in the UK learning Syriac.

We are very blessed that the Bishop has given us permission for this time away. We will not be having any other priest coming to help us, except for the occasional assistance of Fr Jonathan Duncan for the Sunday 6p Mass. Please remember that, by canon law, a priest is only ordinarily allowed to celebrate one Mass a day. In this diocese we are permitted to celebrate two Masses on weekdays and three on Sundays by a special privilege only for grave pastoral reasons. As we are given one day off a week and need to have the flexibility to be able to celebrate wedding and funeral Masses and other Masses as they arise, this will entail a change in the Mass and Confession schedule for weekdays during all of 2020.

Both Father Tomlinson and I will return to the parish after our respective sabbatical periods are over, and we hope to return to the normative Mass schedule in 2021. For 2020:

Tuesday: 6.30p English OF Mass, 7p Confessions
Wednesday: 8.30a School Mass, 5p Confessions
Thursday: 7a English OF Mass
Friday: 12N Latin Low Mass

**Saturday:** 9a Latin Low Mass on First Saturday, 3.30p Confessions

The weekend schedule will not be affected.

Thank you for your patience and may this be a reminder to pray for vocations to the priesthood for service in the Diocese of Charleston.



Fr Smith's advent reading is Searching for and Maintaining Peace: A Small Treatise on Peace of Heart by Fr Jacques Philippe. It can be purchased for \$7.95 from Amazon.

**About the book:** We live in an age characterized by agitation and lack of peace. This tendency manifests itself in our spiritual as well as our secular life. In our search for God and holiness, in our service to our neighbor, a kind of restlessness and anxiety take the place of the confidence and peace which ought to be ours. What must we do to overcome the moments of fear and distress which assail us? How can we learn to place all our confidence in God and abandon ourselves into his loving care? This is what is taught in this simple, yet profound little treatise on peace of head. Taking concrete examples from our everyday life, the author invites us to respond in a Gospel fashion to the upsetting situations we must all confront. Since peace of heart is a pure gift of God, it is something we should seek, pursue and ask him for without cease. This book is here to help us in that pursuit.

Join us for Rorate Mass on Saturdays in Advent, 7, 14 & 21 December, at 6.30a in low extraordinary form. The Rorate Caeli Mass is a traditional Advent devotion wherein the Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary for Advent is offered just before dawn. The Rorate Mass is lit only by candlelight. Because it is a votive Mass in Mary's honor, white vestments are worn instead of Advent violet. In the dimly lit setting, priests and faithful prepare to honor the Light of the world, Who is soon to be born, and offer praise to God for the gift of Our Lady. As the Mass proceeds and sunrise approaches, the church becomes progressively brighter, illumined by the sun as our Faith is illumined by Christ.

#### basketball camp




