# Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

One of the more interesting voices in the current crisis of the Church is the Auxiliary Bishop of Kazakhstan. Bishop Athanasius Schneider, aptly named after the famous Bishop of Alexandria who was a fearless champion of orthodoxy, grew up in the Soviet Union under Communism. This is a man whose family bore heroic witness to the Catholic faith during one of the darkest periods of history. If you are looking for a deeply spiritual response to the insanity that we see all around us, his newest book will not disappoint. *Christus Vincit: Christ's Triumph Over the Darkness of the Age* does more than provide a razor sharp surgical analysis of where we are and how we get here; it is also a deeply hopeful look at how faithful Christians can not only survive, but thrive. On this Feast of the Immaculate Conception, I am reminded of how this quiet and humble man wears an episcopal ring with the Miraculous Medal made into it: *O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee.*

The ex-prefect of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, Gerhard Cardinal Müller, also recently published a book-long interview which you may not want to miss. If Schneider's book is good on history and piety, Müller's is good on theology. *Roman Encounters* uses his extensive experience as a theologian and member of the Pope's Curia to reflect on the unity of the Church and what threatens it. Müller comes from the German context, where many Catholics are pushing agendas to make the Church something radically different than how we know it, and where practice of the faith has collapsed in short order.

Finally, the current Prefect for the Congregation for Divine Worship, Robert Cardinal Sarah, has a new book out in English: *The Day is Now Far Spent*. I have been amazed by his other book-long interviews in recent years, and this is, like the others, destined to be a spiritual masterpiece. This African prelate clearly recognizes the roots of the spiritual malaise which affects the Western world, and brings his considerable acumen to address it.

Many times people come to me for suggestions on good things to read. What I do **not** recommend is wasting your time on the internet reading blogs. The Church needs less up-to-the-minute sensationalism and scandal mongering, and more profound theological and spiritual penetration of what is wrong and what is right with the world, and how to live as a Christian in it. The English author Evelyn Waugh once commented, "Lay interest in ecclesiastical affairs is often a prelude to insanity." Don't be a churchy version of a political junkie, drunk on the human politics of the Church. Jesus is in His Kingdom, trust in Him, and be faithful to His Word.





## Rorate Mass at 6.30a

Join us for Rorate Mass on Saturdays in Advent, 7, 14 & 21 December, at 6.30a in low extraordinary form. The Rorate Caeli Mass is a traditional Advent devotion wherein the Mass of the Blessed Virgin Mary for Advent is offered just before dawn. The Rorate Mass is lit only by candlelight. Because it is a votive Mass in Mary's honor, white vestments are worn instead of Advent violet. In the dimly lit setting, priests and faithful prepare to honor the Light of the world, Who is soon to be born, and offer praise to God for the gift of Our Lady. As the Mass proceeds and sunrise approaches, the church becomes progressively brighter, illumined by the sun as our Faith is illumined by Christ.
