Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

Some of you may remember that, before the renewal of the Adoration Chapel of Christ the King, there was a small statue of the pregnant Virgin Mary that was on a table in the chapel. When the chapel was renewed according to the traditional liturgical norms that govern Solemn Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament, the images were removed from the chapel. For some time now, we have been praying over a location for this lovely image, which was given by a small group of donors who wish to remain anonymous to give all the glory to Our Lady. This striking modern statue was handcrafted out of Dolomite stone and resin by contemplative nuns of the Monastic Fraternity of Bethlehem in France.

Prince of Peace Parish is under the patronage of Our Blessed Lord as the Prince of Peace. Advent and Christmas are particularly special to us for that reason. A niche above the double doors in the narthex has been identified as the perfect place to make into a devotional shrine where the image of Our Lady of the Advent (Vierge de l'Avent) can be placed. Since the Prince of Peace came into the world through Our Lady, who was the first tabernacle of the Real Presence of the God-Man, it is appropriate that the image of Our Lady of the Advent, waiting with expectation the coming of the Savior, greets visitors and parishioners alike, as they go into the church dedicated to the Prince of Peace. The niche has been painted in the blue and gold which are colours associated with Our Lady in the Western tradition, and the statue has been placed in a modern Romanesque style shrine which was purchased from an antiquary in the United States. The image is flanked by vases with silk flowers, and lighting has been arranged to illuminate this new shrine.

Prince of Peace is a 100% pro-life parish, and this unique image of the pregnant Mary is a reminder that mothers are vessels of the sacred transmission of the gift of life. We ask that as you venerate this image, you pray for the following:

1. the intentions of the donors
2. for the sanctification of the mothers of our parish
3. for an end to abortion and the healing of all who have been touched by it
4. in loving memory of children who have been lost by miscarriage, abortion and untimely death and for consolations of their mothers and families

Prayer to Our Lady of the Advent

May the Virgin Mary help us to open the doors of our hearts to Christ, Redeemer of man and of history; may she teach us to be humble, because God looks upon the lowly; may she enable us to grow in understanding the value of prayer, of inner silence, of listening to God's Word; may she spur us to seek God's will deeply and sincerely, even when this upsets our plans; may she encourage us while we wait for the Lord, sharing our time and energies with those in need.

Mother of God, Virgin of expectation, grant that the God-who-comes will find us ready to receive the abundance of his mercy. May Mary Most Holy, "Woman of the Eucharist" and Virgin of Advent, prepare us all to joyfully welcome Christ's coming and to celebrate worthily his sacramental presence in the mystery of the Eucharist.




