# Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

I have been very blessed to be given the resources to travel widely during my life. I don't take any of that for granted, and each trip has opened my mind and heart to the beautiful diversity of the human race and the fundamental values that are part of our unity as rational being created in the image and likeness of God. I have that freedom to travel in a way that many families with their obligations can't, and that gift is both humbling and exciting. I am grateful for our Bishop's allowing me to go on sabbatical, more for study than travel, and I am grateful to my parish family, knowing that it is a sacrifice for you too, but one which I hope will yield great fruit.



This past Christmas was my first Christmas without my mom and dad. Instead of wallowing in sadness at home during the merry octave of Christmas, I got a last minute opportunity to travel to Istanbul, or if you like the song, Constantinople. It was bit weird spending the Octave in a Muslim country, but I was surprised to see Christmas trees and Santa Clauses and winter decorations up everywhere. I had long wanted to spend time in this exotic and historically important city, and I was amazed by what I saw.

As you know, relations between Muslims and Christians have never been easy. Earlier last year, I had spent time in Malta, where a decisive military victory kept the Turks from swarming into Europe in the 16th century. So to see the Turks on their home turf in the same calendar year was amazing. Turkey is a secular country which is seeing a serious renaissance of religious fervor. The adhan, or prayer call, rings out of loudspeakers all over the city five times a day. Many faithful will duck into their closest mosque (and there are so many of them, one more beautiful than the next) and pray. I also found people who were joyful, who took family and friends seriously, and who were incredibly friendly and hospitable.

You and I live in an increasingly secular country. Trends indicate that the United States is becoming less religious every generation. The responsibility for a renewal of faith lies with us. We don't have bells in our church which can ring out the Angelus and call people to Mass (some day, some day!), but we do have people who come to pray literally 24 hours a day in our adoration chapel. We have parishioners who are joyful, who take family and friends seriously, and who are also friendly and hospitable. I think we can outdo our Turkish Muslim brothers and sisters in devotion, and kindness. Let's commit to our little part of the vineyard being a place of spiritual renaissance.



**Feb 11: Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes.** Consider doing a small pilgrimage in your home or home parish to a statue of our Lady and bring her a bouquet of flowers. On your way to the statue, take a short walk while praying a decade of the rosary. Discuss with your children the Catholic tradition of making pilgrimages, especially to Lourdes which is known to have miraculous spiritual and physical healings. **Feb 14: Feast of Sts. Cyril and Methodius.** Although Feb. 14th is traditionally known as Valentine's Day, it is also the feast of two better known and documented saints. Saint Cyril and Methodius were Byzantine brothers and both saints were known for their holiness. The brothers were remembered for having created the Cyrillic alphabet and translated the bible for Eastern Europe people such as the Slavic, Turkish and Persian nations. For a meal serve Sataras which is sautéed tomatoes, eggplant, peppers onions and zucchini over rice - add in ground beef if you wish for some protein!

## fasting & abstinence

The present laws of the Church regarding fast and abstinence during the Season of Lent are as follows:

- Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast. On days of fast, one full meal is allowed. Two lesser meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one’s needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. Catholics who have completed their 18th year are bound by this law until beginning their 60th year.
- Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence. On days of abstinence, meat should not be eaten at any meal. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics who have completed their 14th year.
- The Obligation to observe, as a whole or “substantially,” the penitential days specified by the Church is a serious obligation. The code of Canon Law states: “On these days (of Penance), the faithful are in a special manner to devote themselves to prayer, to engage in works of piety and charity, to deny themselves, by fulfilling their obligations more faithfully and especially by observing the fast and abstinence...”


