Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

My father was driving me home from Midnight Mass one Christmas when I was in high school, when I asked him why there were women without coats on standing on the side of the road with cars pulling up to them. My poor dad had to explain to me what prostitution was. I learned even more about it when, as a seminarian, I was assigned to work in a home for teenage mothers and ex-prostitutes. One of the weirder things that I unfortunately had to get used to in Rome was the regular occurrence of being solicited by male and female prostitutes precisely because I was in a clerical collar, as the seedy underworld of clerical corruption made us a prize target. None of this was an education I ever wanted to receive. But as I have listened to the harrowing stories of ordinary men, women and children who have been caught into the spiderweb of sex trafficking, I have also learned a lot about the power of the human spirit to survive and even thrive through and after the most horrific situations.

As the Church battles to emerge through the abuse crisis, and society finally begins to deal more openly with any number of demons it hid from sight for years, we're not in a position to bury our heads in the sand. The news is so full of stories of kidnappings, homicides, and abuse of all kinds that we can easily become desensitized to it all. But if our churches, our schools and our homes are going to be safe places for everyone to thrive, we cannot afford to not be educated about the grim reality of things we would really rather never think about. So often we think, "That can never happen to us." We tend to have this image in our mind of some creepy psycho lurking in a park in the dark as the kind of person who victimizes other people's children. Unfortunately, the reality is that all of us are at risk in some way or another. During the season of Lent, part of our almsgiving this year as a parish is to understand better the real situation in our own backyard of very sad dynamics happening in broad daylight that often bring poverty, misery and a disintegration of people, families and societies. The more we know, the more we can actually give as a church in a way that protects, defends and elevates all of God's people.

This Saturday at 7p in Parish House we will be having a seminar on sex trafficking. Let me be clear: if you think you don't need to know more, or that this kind of thing is not happening right here in Greenville County, South Carolina, you could *not* be more wrong. Our own parishioner and Lieutenant Governor, Pam Evette, is also scheduled to be with us, and we will learn about the incredible work that Jasmine Road is doing right here at home to give hope to so many who have lost hope because of how others have sinned against them. **Spread the word!**

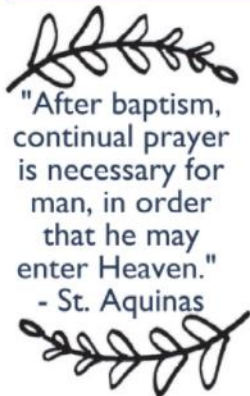

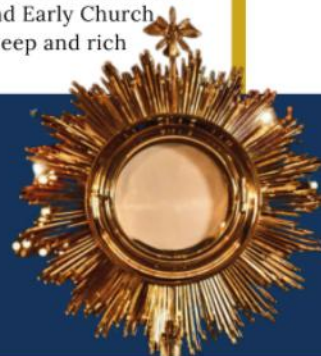
