



#### confession

- During June, confessions will be heard 5-6p Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and 3.30-4.40p on Saturdays in Croghan Hall.
- On I July, we will return to our normal confession schedule of Wednesdays from 5-6p and Saturdays from 3.30-4.40p. We will remain in Croghan Hall to avoid confined spaces.

#### distribution of holy communion after mass

Prince of Peace Catholic Church is unlike any parish in the Upstate in its size. When we re-opened at 25%, our space could accommodate the most people of any local parish with 300. In the Bishop's letter to Diocesan priests, he suggested that "it is permissible at the pastor's discretion that Holy Communion be distributed at the conclusion of Mass as parishioners exit the church." The goal in this suggestion by the Bishop was to allow folks who want to continue receiving a spiritual Communion rather than a sacramental one the opportunity to leave Church as quickly as possible - thereby limiting their exposure. So many are unable to return to Mass and still more are afraid of the time spent in proximity to others and/or inside a building. Due to our size and the amount of time it takes to administer Holy Communion with the other guidelines of social distancing and disinfecting (not to mention the reduce number of folks available to distribute Holy Communion due to their own safety concerns), we needed to be mindful of ways to provide the safest return to Mass and so Fr Smith accepted and practiced the Bishop's recommendation. In July, we'll return to distributing Holy Communion within the Daily Mass.




