# Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

Many people discover the Catholic Church and a relationship with God through the way of beauty. We expend a lot of energy at Prince of Peace in attention to every detail about the sacred liturgy, to be as beautiful as possible. But if the liturgy is not to be reduced to mere aesthetic dilettantism. The liturgy must form our life. When the deacon sings, *The Mass is ended, go in peace*, that is when we go forth from Word and Sacrament to image the presence of God in the world. If we are lacking in our deep interior and active participation in the liturgy, or we fail to let the grace of the Mass flow over into a life of service to others, the Christian life becomes empty and formless.

Dale Ahlquist, the noted Chesterton scholar, recently wrote an article on how the famous social justice pioneer Dorothy Day let her spiritual life drive her work with the poor. As she traveled around helping people, she carried with her the Bible, the Missal, the Breviary and instant coffee. Her faithfulness to the discipline and structure of the liturgy: Daily Mass, the Liturgy of the Hours, and meditation of Sacred Scripture, gave her everything she needed to pursue her work of championing the rights of those who could not speak for themselves, and gave her detachment from the opinions of others. Ahlquist writes:

*Saints become saints through a martyrdom that is usually less dramatic than being eaten by lions. It is rather the slow devouring by people who are petty and demanding and thoughtless and careless. The saint somehow manages to see these people with love and patience, even to see Christ in them, to serve Christ in them. Dorothy had to deal with some of the worst examples of humanity on a daily basis and in close quarters: broken, twisted, vestiges of human beings, drug addicts and drunken priests, unwashed radicals with a random anger at the world, misguided idealists with a passion for justice but with no other moral bearings, and snippy, small-minded critics in every corner. Not to mention the Hell's Angels who dwelt on the same street. She always had to fight off discouragement, which, she writes, "is a temptation of the devil."*

*One cold and rainy day, while looking out the window of a bus, she wrote: "Thinking gloomily of the sins and shortcomings of others, it suddenly came to me to remember my own offenses, just as heinous as those of others. If I concern myself with my own sins and lament them, if I remember my own failures and lapses, I will not be resentful of others. This was most cheering and lifted the load of gloom from my mind. It makes one unhappy to judge people and happy to love them." She believed that the only way we can rebuild the social order is by loving God and loving our neighbors. "If you help people, you begin to love them." She believed that everyone wants to love, but "willingness to suffer is the need. There is no love without it."*

*The saints demonstrate that this supernatural love is not possible without a supernatural connection. The life of prayer is essential to the life of service. Strangely enough, points out Dorothy Day, repeating the same prayers makes them fresh instead of stale. New things stand out. "There is an increase of understanding." It makes sense. If we are praying, it means we have God on our mind.*







celebrating the liturgical life of the church in YOUR home

**23 March: Saint Toribio, or Turibius Alfonso de Mogrovejo**, was born in 1538 in Spain. His father was mayor of the city. At age twelve, he was sent to be educated in the humanities. He then studied law at the University of Salamanca. He was so brilliant a scholar that even though he was a layman, King Philip II appointed him chief judge of the Inquisitorial Court of Granada. As he prosecuted his duties so well, the king proposed him to the pope as the Archbishop of Lima. Gregory XIII named Toribio to this office in 1579, despite the fact that the shocked Toribio pleaded his incapacity for the office and argued that the canons prevented a layman from being appointed. Toribio eventually agreed and was consecrated a bishop. He then set out for the New World. After arriving in Lima in 1581, Toribio wasted no time in getting to work. His archdiocese was huge, encompassing about 400 miles. One of Toribio's greatest accomplishments was overseeing the Third Provincial Council of Lima (1582-1583), one of the most important and far-ranging councils held in the Americas. Among other things, Toribio worked to implement the decrees of the Council of Trent in the Americas. He focused on the reformation of the clergy and the evangelization of the Indians. Toribio established the first seminary in the New World at Lima in 1590. Toribio also conducted pastoral visitations of his diocese, travelling across the entirety of the territory by foot. His visits took seventeen years to accomplish, covering 18,000 miles. Moving from parish to parish, he made an effort to know and instruct his flock, whether Spanish or Indian. For the salvation of souls, he made nocturnal journeys during torrential downpours of rain or on rugged paths covered in snow. Even on these long journeys, Toribio always said mass each morning and made a daily confession to his chaplain. In order to reach all of his flock, Toribio traversed steep and rugged mountains, sometimes by himself, to bring the Gospel to the natives in outlying areas. Oftentimes, he would dwell in the hut of the Incas for a few days with no food or bedding, preaching to the whole tribe, baptizing and confirming them. Toribio saw himself as a missionary and "Protector of the Indians." St. Toribio also personally knew some of the great saints of South America. He gave the Sacrament of Confirmation to St. Rose of Lima, St. Martin de Porres and St. John Macias. He was also a good friend to St. Francis Solano, "the Wonderworker of the New World." On one of his many journeys, Toribio was taken ill. He died on March 23, 1606, repeating the very words of Christ, "Into thy hands, I commend my spirit." Toribio was beatified by Innocent XI in 1697 and canonized by Benedict XIII in 1726. Together with Rose of Lima, St. Toribio is the first known saint of the New World. He is the patron saint of indigenous/Native rights, Latin American bishops, and Peru.

- St. Toribio fought for social justice, championing the rights of the natives against the Spanish masters. Make a contribution to your local food pantry, volunteer at a crisis pregnancy center, cut out pictures of children from third world countries and make a display in your home to encourage your children to make sacrifices or to contribute money to those less fortunate.




