Letter from our Pastor

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

People from all over join us at Prince of Peace for the beautiful and stirring ceremonies that take place here during Holy Week. I look forward all year long to leading people through these magnificent rites, and even if I have to crawl in the tomb on Easter Sunday for three days to rest after it all, it is the highlight of my year. Last year, I celebrated the rites alone with Kylee on the other side of a cell phone as you had to watch Holy Week from home while we had the weirdest celebration of the Paschal Mystery we could possibly imagine. Those who had the sense to glean the spiritual lessons from the plague were smart enough to not take our worship for granted ever again. This year, the lingering effects of this time mean that we cannot celebrate the rites entirely like we did before. There will be shorter services, but more of them; they will be simpler, but no less elegant. We invite you to come to all you can, and if you haven't come back to church yet after the pandemic, Easter is a bright time to come home. There's something for everyone.

Father Clement Lloyd Russell became the pastor of a new parish in the suburbs of London, St George, Sudbury, in the 1920s and set about creating a community of Catholics who were well formed in the liturgical and spiritual patrimony of their English Catholic heritage. Sundays and Feasts were celebrated with Vespers and Solemn Masses, processions and blessings of all kinds marked the rhythm of the sacred year, and servers, choir and laypeople all contributed to a unique parish. He would get annoyed when his flock chose secular entertainments over divine worship, and when he was discouraged, he would tell the brave souls who did come that regardless how many people were there, the church was full of angels, so it was always full at every Mass. He got run over by a bus at the age of 80, still gloriously reigning in a parish whose life and ministry has inspired much of what we do to bring the Roman tradition to South Carolina.

He wrote in a bulletin column in 1940 words that summarize what I feel to be my life's work and the vision we have for Prince of Peace that I leave you with as we celebrate the Paschal Mystery this week:

And beyond all, I want the sanctuary, especially at sung Mass and at vespers and benediction, to speak to people of the glories of Heaven, and that, as far as is humanly possible, there shall be gathered there a splendour of colour and light, beauty of vesture, and ordered movement that compels the most wandering and distracted of undisciplined minds to realise that something far, far more than the satisfaction of human devotion is being accomplished – that the eternal and invisible GOD is being worshipped, and that all that is being done, is performed to render the easier, a response to the invitation "Sursum Corda!" There, at all events, is and has been my great endeavour.

laws on fasting and abstinence

The present laws of the Church regarding fasting and abstinence during the Season of Lent are as follows:

1. **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday** are days of **fasting**. On days of fasting, one full meal is allowed. Two lesser meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. Catholics who have completed their 18th year are bound by this law until the beginning of their 60th year.
2. **Ash Wednesday and all Fridays** of Lent are also days of abstinence. On days of abstinence, meat should not be eaten at any meal. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics who have completed their 14th year.

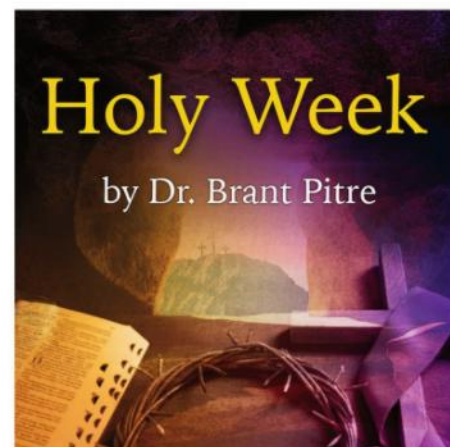
