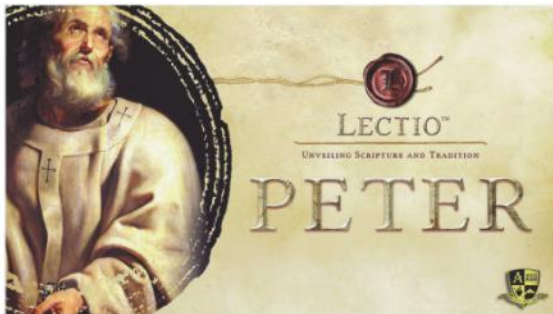
THE BIBLE COLLECTION - PAUL THE APOSTLE

Celebrating the Liturgical Life of the Church

1 July: Feast of Saint Junipero Serra. Born on the Spanish island of Mallorca in 1713 as Miquel Joseph Serra Ferrer, he joined the Franciscan order as a young man and took the name “Junipero” in honor of St. Juniper, a companion of St. Francis of Assisi. Until he was thirty-five, he spent most of his time in the classroom: first as a student of theology and then as a professor. He also became famous for his preaching. He then followed the yearning that had begun years before when he heard about the missionary work of Saint Francis Solanus in South America. Junipero's desire was to convert native peoples in the New World. Arriving by ship, he and a companion walked 250 miles to Mexico City. On the way, Junipero was bitten on his leg by a serpent. This did not stop him from continuing the long journey. The painful bite became infected. This serious injury would plague Junipero the rest of his life. For eighteen years he worked in central Mexico and in the Baja Peninsula. He became president of the missions there. He was often required to balance the conflicting demands of the church, the military, and civil authorities (including the Spanish governor). Under his leadership, the missions became self-sufficient, and many grew into thriving settlements – the basis for some of California's most important cities. Then, with a threat of Russian invasion, Charles III of Spain ordered an expedition to beat Russia to new territory. The military leader persuaded Junipero to set out with him for present-day Monterey, California. The first mission founded after the nine-hundred-mile journey north was San Diego. Junipero went on to establish eight other California missions, one of the most famous being San Juan Capistrano, known for its annually returning swallows. Junipero then made the long trip back to Mexico City to settle differences with the military commander. He arrived at the point of death. The outcome eventually was what Junipero sought: the famous "Regulation" protecting the Indians and the missions. It was the basis for the first significant legislation in California, a "Bill of Rights" for Native Americans. Junipero's missionary life was a long battle with cold and hunger, with unsympathetic military commanders and even with danger of death from non-Christian native peoples. Through it all his unquenchable zeal was fed by prayer each night, often from midnight until dawn. He baptized over six thousand people and confirmed five thousand. His travels would have circled the globe. He brought the Native Americans not only the gift of faith but also a decent standard of living. He won their love, as witnessed especially by their inconsolable grief at his death. He is buried at Mission San Carlo Borromeo, Carmel. To this day, Father Serra is known as the father of the California Missions, and even California's founding father. He was beatified by JP II in 1988. On September 23, 2015, Pope Francis canonized Junipero Serra at the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C. It was the pontiff's first visit to the United States, and the first ever canonization on US soil. St. Junipero is the patron saint of vocations.

The lamb sitting, angel, ox and donkey, have been paid for, but we need funds to get them here. For the crates and shipping of all the nativity pieces it is about \$18,000.

Besides shipping, we still need donations for the 3 wisemen. If there are groups that would like to get together and donate for a particular piece or if your work matches donations, that is a great way to help us achieve our goals.
