# From our Principal

An Extraordinary Parish for Ordinary People

Dear Friends in Christ,

Schools all over the United States recently finished an unprecedented year in education. We were very blessed to remain open and in person throughout the school year. I want to thank all of our faculty, staff, families and students for the diligent commitment to remain in school and follow through on all of the safety protocols that allowed us to navigate the pandemic. This coming fall we look forward to a return to normal and, hopefully, a year unfettered by restrictive protocols.

Despite the challenges posed by the pandemic, we were a witness to the continued growth in our school enrollment. From a first day enrollment of 144 in the fall of 2018, our enrollment has grown to over 180 for the coming school year, with waiting lists now established in K5, 1st, 2nd and 4th grade. Many new families over the last year joined us as an opportunity to remain in person for school, and then chose to stay for this coming year when they experienced the fullness of the school's mission in our classrooms and hallways.

As a school we have been so very blessed by the charitable support of our families and stakeholders. During a year that was a witness to a challenging economic landscape, we were still able to benefit from an outpouring of financial support for our programs and students. Our recent POPArt Party celebration was intended to be just that, a time to gather in spirit and fellowship after a long time apart. The end result was a testament to the commitment of our stakeholders to the mission of the school. With a budgeted goal of \$20,000 we were a witness in over \$70,000 in proceeds for the school at the end of the night. Additionally, with a modest goal of \$30,000 set for our school annual fund, we were able to realize a tremendous tally of over \$50,000 in donations to the school by year's end. Moreover, over 70% of the contributions to the annual fund comes from benefactors who do not have children attending the school. This affirms support from both within and outside the immediate school community.

Enrollment and development serve as the foundation for private schools, and we are very blessed to finally be on solid financial footing as we approach the 2021-2022 school year. Like all private schools, we weathered the loss in revenue as schools turned to remote learning in the spring of 2020 and the uncertainty of what impact the pandemic would have for the fall. During the course of the school year we were able to grow enrollment and charitable giving to the school. This strengthening financial position affords us the latitude to address a number of important needs that impact the school and parish:

- Expanding our scholarship pool for families with financial need and reducing the pressure on tuition increases. Currently, 25% of students attending our school receive some financial aid, up from 18% last year.
- Further partnering with the parish in the care and upkeep of the campus.
- Expanding our academic program to include Latin and Humanities in our elementary division.
- Expanding our student support program to include an Academic Interventionist and Support Specialist position.
- Implementing a Culture of Life Studies program in K4 through 8th grade.
- Upgrading and expanding technology resources to include Chromebook carts in each classroom.

We remain blessed and honored to serve as the primary apostolate of Prince of Peace Catholic Church, and we look forward to continuing the tradition of academic excellence and spiritual formation that has been a hallmark of the school. In turn, we continue to embrace the mission of the parish: *To share in the fullness of the Gospel to all that we encounter in our lives by equipping disciples to create and strengthen a personal relationship with Christ. By the grace of God, we are called to strive for personal holiness, participate fully in the vibrant life of the Church's Tradition and transform the world.*



# Celebrating the Liturgical Life of the Church

**23 July: Feast of Saint Bridget.** Bridget was born in Sweden of noble and pious parents, and led a holy life. At ten years old, she heard a sermon on the Passion of our Lord. The next night, she saw Jesus on the cross, covered with blood, and speaking to her about his Passion. From then on, meditation on Our Lord's Passion affected her so deeply that she could never think of it without tears. She was given in marriage to Ulfo the prince of Nericia; and won him, by example and persuasion, to a life of piety. She lived happily with him for 28 years, bearing him eight children. St. Catherine of Sweden was their daughter. Bridget was very devoted to the education of her children. She was also zealous in serving the poor, especially the sick; and set apart a house for their reception, where she would often wash and kiss their feet. Together with her husband, she went on pilgrimage to Compostella, to visit the tomb of the apostle St. James. On their return journey, Ulfo fell dangerously ill. Saint Dionysius appeared to Bridget at night and foretold the restoration of her husband's health, along with other future events. Ulfo did recover and became a Cistercian monk. He died not long after becoming a monk. After her husband's death, Bridget founded the Order of the Most Holy Savior, erecting at Vadstena a double monastery for monks and nuns.



Following the guidance of the Holy Spirit, she later went to Rome, where she worked for the return of the Popes from Avignon. Bridget would hear the voice of Christ calling to her in her dreams. She was a mystic, embracing an austere manner of life. Many secrets were revealed to her by God. St. Bridget is most known for the Revelations given to her concerning the sufferings of our Redeemer. After Bridget had kindled the love of God in many hearts in the city of Rome, she made a pilgrimage to Jerusalem. On her return trip, she was attacked by fever, and suffered severe sickness for an entire year. On a day she had foretold, she then passed into eternal life. Her body was taken to her monastery of Vadstena. Bridget quickly became renowned for miracles, and was named a saint by Boniface IX. The order she founded, named the Order of the Most Holy Savior (Brigittines) at Vadstena, received confirmation by Pope Urban V in 1370, and survives today. The new branch of the order was re-founded by Blessed Elisabeth Hesselblad and has grown substantially around the world. Bridget is the patron saint of Europe, Sweden, and widows.
