# From Maria Barontini

Dear Friends in Christ,

Parents are the primary educators and influencers of their children in their Catholic Faith however, your parish is here to assist in that education. It's that time of year to register your children for Religious Education at our parish. Religious Education is available for registered parishioners' children K5-8<sup>th</sup> grade. If you chose to homeschool your child(ren) and are teaching religion at home, please still fill out a registration form and turn it into me. This serves as a record for sacramental preparation. In the Diocese of Charleston two years of preparation are required for First Holy Communion and Confirmation. That traditionally means students should be registered for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Religious Education at a bare minimum. However, it is best to participate in classes every single year starting in K5. Let's pretend your child only participated up until 2<sup>nd</sup> grade and then disappeared from our program during 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Your child then reappears in the 7<sup>th</sup> grade with only the knowledge of a second grader, missing out on in-depth study of the Ten Commandments, the Sacraments, general Bible knowledge, the Mass, and so much more. It would be like dropping out of math in the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade and expecting your child to have the building blocks of knowledge to succeed in algebra. Please, do not be a disappearing family after First Holy Communion. 2021-2022 Religious Education sessions begin on 22 August at 8:50a. Additional instructions will be sent in August, once your child is registered for Religious Education.

Registration forms for First Holy Communion and Confirmation will be available in mid-August. Please reach out to me, via e-mail if your child is homeschooled or at another local Catholic school besides POPCS. All RE and POPCS students will receive their forms in early September. We will have a **MANDATORY** parent meeting on Thursday 16 September in the Parish House. First Holy Communion parents will meet at 6p and Confirmation parents will meet at 7:30p. One parent per child is required to be in attendance unless arrangements for an individual meeting are made with me. Please bring a copy of your child's baptismal certificate, the completed registration form, and fee to the meeting. All fees for sacraments go towards the purchase of curriculum, retreat costs, and reception costs. The amount collected each year rarely covers the cost associated with First Holy Communion or Confirmation and the parish makes up the difference. If ANY family is unable to pay a fee, please reach out to me and I will work something out with each individual family. First Holy Communion 2022 is scheduled for April 30 at the **5p Mass**. Please note the change in time from previous years. Confirmation is scheduled by the Bishop's office and we do not have our date for Confirmation 2022.







# Celebrating the Liturgical Life of the Church

## 27 & 28 August: Feasts of Saint Monica and Saint Augustine.

The feast of Saint Monica is celebrated the day before that of her son, Saint Augustine; a fitting combination. Born of Christian parents in Tagaste, North Africa in 333, Monica was married early in life to a man named Patritius. He was a pagan, known for a violent temper and immoral habits. Monica's almsgiving and constant prayer annoyed him. They had three children, Augustine, Navigius, and a daughter, Perpetua (who later became a nun). As a mother, Monica's anxiety centered on Augustine: he was wayward and, as he himself tells us, lazy. He was sent to Madaura to school and Monica seems to have literally wrestled with God for the soul of her son.



During this time, Monica received a great consolation when Patritius converted to Christianity before his death. Augustine then became a Manichean, which caused Monica to kick him out of her house. She went tearfully to the bishop to ask for help and he responded famously, "Don't worry, it is impossible that a son of so many tears should be lost." One night, Augustine left for Rome and Monica followed him the whole way and met St. Ambrose who played a key role in Augustine's conversion. Monica died at Ostia, near Rome in 387. On the day after St. Monica's feast, the Church honors St. Augustine. Augustine was born on November 13, 354. The story of his life is written in the autobiographical *Confessions*. Augustine, though brought up early as a Christian, lived a life of revelry and sin, and drifted away from the Church. He enjoyed the pursuit of pleasure above all things. He was well-known in Carthage for his brilliant mind and rhetorical skills and sought a career as an orator or lawyer. He also fell in love with philosophy. He then went to Rome and later Milan where he met Saint Ambrose, the bishop and Doctor of the Church, whose sermons inspired him to look for the truth he had always sought in the faith he had rejected. He was baptized by St. Ambrose and soon after, his mother died knowing her prayers had been answered. Augustine returned to Africa, "having now cast off from himself the cares of the world, he lived for God... in fasting, prayers, and good works, meditating on the law of the Lord by day and by night." On a visit to Hippo he was proclaimed priest and then bishop against his will. He later accepted it as the will of God and spent the rest of his life as the pastor of Hippo, from where he spent much time refuting the writings of heretics. He wrote more than one hundred works of theology, apologetics, and philosophy, including his famous *The City of God*. He died of illness at age seventy-five and was venerated as a saint immediately. Augustine was recognized as a Doctor of the Church in 1298. He is known as one of the most significant and influential thinkers in the history of the Catholic Church. His teachings were the foundation of Christian doctrine for a millennium.

### Ideas for celebrating these feast days at home:

- **Saint Monica** is known for her persistent prayers. Make soft pretzels - their form represents folded hands in prayer! [Recipe here.](#)
- **St. Monica** is the patron saint of mothers: consider her feast a special **mother's day**. Do something nice for your mom. If she is in heaven, offer prayers and sacrifices on her behalf.
- In honor of St. Augustine, consider adding religious artwork to your home to provide daily reminders of God's Presence. "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in you." (St. Augustine, *Confessions*)

- Through the persistent prayer of his mother, St. Augustine converted and became one of the most influential thinkers of the Church. Pray in a special way for the conversion of sinners on these feasts. Remember to pray especially for family and friends that have fallen away from the church.
